Beskrywing

Die historiese Ganesha-Tempel geleë op die restant van Perseel 22 op die Umhlangarivier, county Victoria, en groot eenduisend sewehonderd agt-en-dertig (1 738) akker, een (1) roede en agt-en-twintig desimaal vyf vyf agt (28,558) "perches".

Transportakte 1547/1921, gedateer 26 April 1921 (paragraaf 8).

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Hierdie Hindoetempel is die eerste bouwerk van die bekende argitek en bouer, Kristappa Reddy. Die gebou is in 1899 opgerig en vorm 'n unieke deel van Suid-Afrika se kulturele en argitektoniese erfenis. 10/2/484.

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL
MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic Ganesha Temple at Mount Edgecombe, Natal, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic Ganesha Temple, situate on the remainder of Lot 22 on the Umhlanga River, County of Victoria, in extent one thousand seven hundred and thirty-eight (1 738) acres, one (1) rood and twenty-eight decimal five five eight (28,558) perches.

Deed of Transfer 1547/1921, dated 26 April 1921 (paragraph 8).

Historical and architectural interest

This Hindu temple is the first building by the well-known architect and builder, Kristappa Reddy. The building was erected in 1899 and forms a unique part of South Africa's cultural and architectural heritage. 10/2/484.

Wapen.—Gevierendeel: 1, in blou, uitkomende van twee golwende versmalde dwarsbalke in die skildvoet, 'n galei in volle seil, vlag en wimpels wapperende na regs, alles van silwer; 2, in silwer, 'n Tudor-roos, geknop en gepunt van natuurlike kleur; 3, in silwer, 'n dissels gestingel en geblaar van natuurlike kleur; 4, in blou, 'n valhek van silwer; die skild gedek deur 'n muurkroon van rooi, gemessel en met 'n pylgleuf, albei van silwer.
