NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

ENTRIES IN THE REGISTER OF IMMOVABLE CONSERVATION-WORTHY PROPERTY

In terms of section 5 (1) (cC) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), the National Monuments Council hereby enters in the official register of immovable property as fully described in the Schedule hereto and which the Council regards as worthy of conservation on account of its historical, cultural or aesthetic interest.

SCHEDULE

1. The Izotsha railway bridge, situated on Subdivision 1 of Lot 1174, Shelley Beach, and the Marburg Commonage 12225, Port Shepstone District.
2. The Ottawa Shree Emperumal Temple, situated on the Remainder of Lot 20 No. 1557, on the Ottawa Estate, Inanda District.
3. The house known as Bogmore, including the gardens, situated on Subdivision 3 of the farm Compensation 868, Lower Tugela District.
4. The Eshowe Primary School, situated on Lot 1139 at 57 Main Road, Eshowe, Eshowe District.
5. The Aird farmhouse, situated on the Remainder of Subdivision 31 of the farm Petrusstroom 954, Lions River District.
6. The property known as Lot 33, at 11 Arbuckle Street, Himeville, Underberg District.
