DECLARATION OF THE COMMANDANT'S HOUSE  
AND THE DOCTORS' QUARTERS AT THE WESTON  
AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE NEAR MOOI RIVER, NA-  
TAL

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pierre Cronjé, Deputy Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Commandant's House and the Doctors' Quarters at the Weston Agricultural College near Mooi River, Natal, together with their present fenced gardens, to be national monuments.

*Description*

The Commandant's House and the Doctors' Quarters, together with their present fenced gardens, situate on the farm Weston Training School 13981, in the County of Weenen, Province of Natal, in extent two thousand five hundred (2 500) acres.

Deed of Transfer 5/1954, dated 21 January 1954.

*Historical and architectural interest*

These two wood-and-iron houses, which were erected in 1900, are relics of the British Military Remount Depot that was established at Weston near Mooi River shortly before the outbreak of the Anglo-Boer War (1899-1902). 10/2/1204.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Oorlogsgrafte en Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Pierre Cronjé, Adjunk-minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die Kommandantshuis en die Dokterskwartiere by die Weston-Landboukollege naby Mooirivier, Natal, tesame met hulle huidige omheinde tuine, tot nasionale gedenkwaardighede.

*Beskrywing*

Die Kommandantshuis en die Dokterskwartiere, tesame met hul huidige omheinde tuine, geleë op die plaas Weston Training School 13981, in die county Weenen, provinsie Natal, in omvang tweeduisend vyfhonderd (2 500) acre.

*Historiese en argitektoniese belang*

Hierdie twee hout-en-ysterhuise wat in 1900 opgerig is, is oorblyfsels van die Britse militêre perdevoorsieningsdepot wat by Weston naby Mooirivier gevestig is kort vóór die Anglo-Boereoorlog (1899-1902) uitbreek het. 10/2/1204.
