NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE CARNEGIE LIBRARY BUILDING THEREON, AT VRYHEID, NATAL

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property together with the so-called Carnegie Library building thereon, at Vryheid, Natal, to be a national monument.

Description

The property together with the Carnegie Library building thereon, situate on certain piece of land in the Township of Vryheid, Natal, measuring 1 (one) rood, 407 (four hundred and seven) perches, known as subdivision Carnegie Public Library Site of Erf 124 (now known as Portion 1 of Erf 124 Vryheid).

Crown Grant 7229/1908, dated 21 February 1908.

Historical and architectural interest

This imposing Edwardian building was erected in 1908 with funds granted by the Carnegie Trust. The land on which the building stands was a gift from the Vryheid Town Council. 10/2/863.

VERKLARING VAN DIE EIENDOM MET DIE CARNEGIE-BIBLIOTEEKGEBOU DAAROP, TE VRYHEID, NATAL

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die eiendom tesame met die sogenaamde Carnegie-biblioteekgebou daarop, te Vryheid, Natal, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Die eiendom, tesame met die Carnegie-biblioteekgebou daarop, geleë op 'n sekere stuk grond in die dorp Vryheid, Natal, groot 1 (een) roede, 407 (vierhonderd en sewe) "perches" en bekend as Onderverdeling Carnegie Openbare Biblioteek-perseel van Erf 124 (nou bekend as Ge-deelte 1 van Erf 124, Vryheid).

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Hierdie imposante Eduardiaanse gebou is in 1908 opgerig met fondse toegeken deur die Carnegie Trust. Die grond waarop die gebou staan, is geskenk deur die Stadsraad van Vryheid. 10/2/863.
