Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Hierdie indrukwekkende rooibaksteengebou, wat deur die argitek Price en Agutter ontwerp is, is deur die boukontrakteurs Kelly en Anderson van Johannesburg opgerig. Die hoeksteen van die gebou is op 2 Augustus 1907 deur sir Hamilton Goold-Adams gelê. Die Stadsaal is op 7 September 1908 amptelik ingewy. RNG 10/2/1053.

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,

DECLARATION OF THE TOWN HALL BUILDING,
SITUATED IN WARDEN STREET, HARRISMITH

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Town Hall building, situated in Warden Street, Harrismith, to be a national monument.

Description

The Town Hall building, situate on a portion of the Townlands of Harrismith Division of Harrismith.

Land Grant 131, dated 9 July 1877.

Historical and architectural interest

This impressive red brick building, which was designed by the architects Price and Agutter, was erected by the builders Kelly and Anderson of Johannesburg. The cornerstone of the building was laid by Sir Hamilton Goold-Adams on 2 August 1907. The Town Hall was officially inaugurated on 7 September 1908. RNG 10/2/1053.
