VERKLARING VAN DIE EIENDOM MET DIE PROVINSIALE GEBOU (VOORHEEN DIE OU STANDARD BANK-GEBOU) DAAROP, GELEË TE TERMINUS-  
STRAAT 64, OOS-LONDEN

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Oorlogsgrafte en Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die eiendom met die Provinsiale Gebou (voorheen die Ou Standard Bank-gebou) daarop, geleë te Terminusstraat 64, Oos-Londen, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

*Beskrywing*

Die eiendom met die historiese dubbelverdiepinggebou daarop, geleë soos volg:

1. Erf 15467, Oos-Londen, munisipaliteit en afdeling Oos-Londen, en groot seshonderd-en-sewe (607) vierkante meter; en
2. Erf 15468, Oos-Londen, munisipaliteit en afdeling Oos-Londen, en groot seshonderd-en-vyftien (615) vierkante meter.

*Historiese en argitektoniese belang*

Hierdie manjefieke dubbelverdiepinggebou wat 'n goeie voorbeeld van Neo-Renaissance-herlewing is, is in twee stadiums opgerig. Die oorspronklike gebou is in 1900 op Perseel 11 opgerig en in 1927 oor Perseel 12 uitgebrei. Die gebou wat prominent geleë is op 'n hoekperseel, vorm 'n integreerende deel van die argitektoniese stadsgesig van Oos-Londen en is 'n landmerk in die dorp. 10/2/1076.

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE PROVINCIAL BUILDING (FORMERLY THE OLD STANDARD BANK BUILDING) THEREON, SITUATED AT  
64 TERMINUS STREET, EAST LONDON

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the Provincial Building (formerly the Old Standard Bank Building) thereon, situated at 64 Terminus Street, East London, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The property with the historic double-storeyed building thereon, situate as follows:

1. Erf 15467, East London, Municipality and Division of East London, in extent six hundred and seven (607) square metres; and
2. Erf 15468, East London, Municipality and Division of East London, in extent six hundred and fifteen (615) square metres.

Deed of Transfer T1025/1977, dated 13 June 1977.

*Historical and architectural interest*

This magnificent double-storeyed building, which is a fine example of Neo-Renaissance revivalism, was erected in two stages. The original building was erected on Lot 11 in 1900 and extended onto Lot 12 in 1927. The building, which is prominently situated on a corner site, forms an integral part of the architectural townscape of East London and is a landmark in the town. 10/2/1076.
