

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS ERF 768, INCLUSIVE OF THE DOUBLE-STOREYED GEORGIAN DWELLING-HOUSE, AS WELL AS THE OUTBUILDINGS THEREON, SITUATED AT 3 D'URBAN ROW, COLESBERG

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property known as Erf 768, inclusive of the double-storeyed Georgian dwelling-house, as well as the outbuildings thereon, situated at 3 D'Urban Row, Colesberg, to be a national monument.

Description

The property, inclusive of the buildings thereon, known as Erf 768 (a portion of Erf 767), Colesberg, situate in the Municipality and Division of Colesberg, in extent one thousand four hundred and fifty (1 450) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 19526/1983, dated 6 June 1983.

Historical and architectural interest

This property with its double-storeyed Georgian house forms an integral part of the historic core of Colesberg. The house dates from the 1830s while the stables and rondavel-shaped building at the rear are presumably much older.
