# DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE VIC-TORIAN DWELLING-HOUSE THEREON, SITUATED AT 7 UNION STREET, GARDENS, CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the Victorian dwelling-house thereon, situated at 7 Union Street, Gardens, Cape Town, to be a national monument.

### Description

The property with the Victorian dwelling-house thereon, situated on Erf 95081, Cape Town at Gardens, in the City of Cape Town, Cape Division, in extent four hundred and fifty-one (451) square metres.

### Historical and architectural interest

This impressive house, with its unusual hexagonal turret that surmounts the front verandah, was presumably erected in 1895. Its magnificent marble fireplaces are an exceptional feature. 10/2/1139.
