

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE VICTORIAN HOUSE KNOWN AS GROVE HOUSE THEREON, SITUATED AT 4 GROVE ROAD, GREEN POINT, CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pierre Cronjé, Deputy Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the Victorian house known as Grove House thereon, situated at 4 Grove Road, Green Point, Cape Town, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the Victorian house known as Grove House thereon, described as certain piece of land situate in the City of Cape Town, Cape Division, being the Remainder of Erf 696, Green Point, and in extent 1 578 (one thousand five hundred and seventy-eight) square metres.

Historical and architectural interest

Grove House in its present form dates from the late nineteenth century. As such it is a good example of Victorian architecture. (RNG 10/2/1166.)
