

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE VICTORIAN DWELLING-
HOUSE, SITUATED AT 2 PATRIOT STREET, PAARL

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pierre Cronjé, Deputy Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Victorian dwelling-house, situated at 2 Patriot Street, Paarl, together with 1,9 metres of surrounding land, to be a national monument.

Description

The Victorian dwelling-house, together with 1,9 metres of surrounding land, situate on certain piece of land, being Erf 2107, Paarl, in the Municipality and Division of Paarl and measuring 1 459 (one thousand four hundred and fifty-nine) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 23930/1982, dated 2 July 1982.

Historical and architectural interest

This impressive dwelling-house which was erected in 1905 by Wilhelm Bruckner de Villiers in the late-Victorian style, not only forms an essential part of the traditional architectural street scene of Patriot Street, but also an integral part of the historic core of Paarl. 10/2/1172.
