WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE HISTORIC HOMESTEAD OF THE FARM KROMBEKSRIVIER IN THE HEIDEL-BERG DISTRICT, TOGETHER WITH 10 METRES OF SURROUNDING LAND

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pierre Cronjé, Deputy Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic homestead of the farm Krombeksrivier in the Heidelberg District, together with 10 metres of surrounding land, to be a national monument.

Description

The Cape Dutch farmhouse, together with 10 metres of surrounding land, situate on the Remainder of Portion 33 of the farm Karnemelks Rivier 250 in the Division of Riversdale.

Deed of Transfer 57432/1983, dated 12 December 1983.

Historical and architectural interest

This farmhouse, built predominantly in the Cape Dutch style, was erected in about 1740–1744. The Krombeksrivier homestead is not only one of the oldest farmhouses in the vicinity but also one of the earliest outspans on the road to the eastern frontier. 10/2/1218.
