DECLARATION OF THE FIVE PROPERTIES, INCLU-SIVE OF THE GEORGIAN DOUBLE-STOREYED TER-RACED HOUSES THEREON, SITUATED AT 14 WAN-DEL STREET, 14, 16 AND 20 DUNKLEY STREET AND 31 BARNET STREET, GARDENS, CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Frederik Willem de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the five properties, inclusive of the Georgian double-storeyed terraced houses thereon, situated at 14 Wandel Street, 14, 16 and 20 Dunkley Street and 31 Barnet Street, Gardens, Cape Town, to be national monuments.

## Description

The five properties, inclusive of the Georgian doublestoreyed terraced houses thereon, described as follows:

(a) 14 Wandel Street, Gardens:

Subdivision 1 of certain piece of land, being Erf 96170, a portion of Erf 95605, Cape Town, situated at Gardens in the Municipality of Cape Town, Cape Division, in extent one hundred and five (105) square metres.

(b) 14 Dunkley Street, Gardens:

Subdivision 2 of certain piece of land, being Erf 96170, a portion of Erf 95605, Cape Town, situated at Gardens in the Municipality of Cape Town, Cape Division, in extent one hundred and seven (107) square metres. Certificate of Registered Sectional Title 42/1980

(c) 16 Dunkley Street, Gardens:

Subdivision 5 of certain piece of land, being Erf 96170, a portion of Erf 95605, Cape Town, situated at Gardens in the Municipality of Cape Town, Cape Division, in extent one hundred and nine (109) square metres. Certificate of Registered Sectional Title 42/1980

(e) 31 Barnet Street, Gardens:

Subdivision 9 of certain piece of land, being Erf 96170, a portion of Erf 95605, Cape Town, situated at Gardens in the Municipality of Cape Town, Cape Division, in extent ninety-three (93) square metres.

These five properties form an integral part of a row of nine double-storeyed Cape-Georgian terraced houses that were erected in 1886 by William James Hadfield. The corner shop units were added in 1901.
