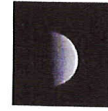

NOTICE OF INTENT TO REBURY HUMAN REMAINS ACCIDENTALLY UNEARTHED AT GA-MOGASHOA VILLAGE DURING TRENCHING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A BULK WATER SUPPLY PIPELINE


This letter serves to inform you of plans to rebury human remains accidentally exposed during trenching for the installation for a bulk water supply pipeline at Ga-Mogashoa Vilage. The matter was brought to our attention as heritage management specialist. An application will be lodged with the South African Heritage Resources Agency Burial Grounds and Graves Unit (SAHRA BGG) in order to obtain a permit as required in terms Section 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act (No 25/1999), to rebury the remains in a formal cemetery.

At the present time, with the concurrence of the Ga-Mogashoa Traditional Authority, and in accordance with SAHRA regulation the human bones have been taken to the University of Pretoria Forensic Anthropology Research Centre, while arrangements are being made for reburial.

As part of Stakeholder consultation we are required to advise the local Police Station Commander. I wish further to reassure you that the process followed is transparent as as this project has the support of the Ga-Mogashoa Traditional Authority.

As required by SAHRA BGG, I should be most grateful to receive an official stamp on this letter as acknowledgement of this notification.
