Luckily two friendly and helpful police officers were on hand to help. Helen Engelbrecht said she was visiting her daughter in Randfontein on 1 October.

"I opened the back door to take stuff off the seat and accidentally locked the back door," she explained.

It was only then that she realised she had locked her car keys inside. As she was trying to figure out how to get the keys out of the car, a crowd started gathering to see if they could help the almost 80-year-old woman and her daughter.

"They need a pat on the back. I wanted to give them a pat on the back to thank them, but it was their duty. They are honest and nice," she said.
