
NOTICE OF INTENT TO REBURY HUMAN REMAINS RESCUED FROM THE SITE OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MANOGENG SWITCHING STATION NEAR ROOSSENEKAL IN THE ELIAS MOTSOLEDI LOCAL MUNICIPALITY

This letter serves to inform you of plans to rebury the human remains which have been rescued from the footprint of the construction of the Manogeng Switching Station. As you are aware, we have been working in close collaboration with your Station since our appointment by Eskom as the heritage service provider.

We further would like to inform you that an application will be lodged with the South African Heritage Resources Agency Burial Grounds and Graves Unit (SAHRA BGG) in order to obtain a permit as required in terms of section 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act (No 25 of 1999), to rebury the human remains in accordance with the wishes of descendant families.

As you are also aware, at present time negotiations among four groups of descendants to find a common position are in progress, and we will allow this process to play out. I, therefore, wish to assure you that the stakeholder engagement process is transparent.

As part of the stakeholder consultation process, we are required to advise the local Police Station commander about the planned reburial. To meet the requirements of the SAHRA BGG, I would be grateful to receive an official stamp on this letter as your acknowledgment of this notification.
