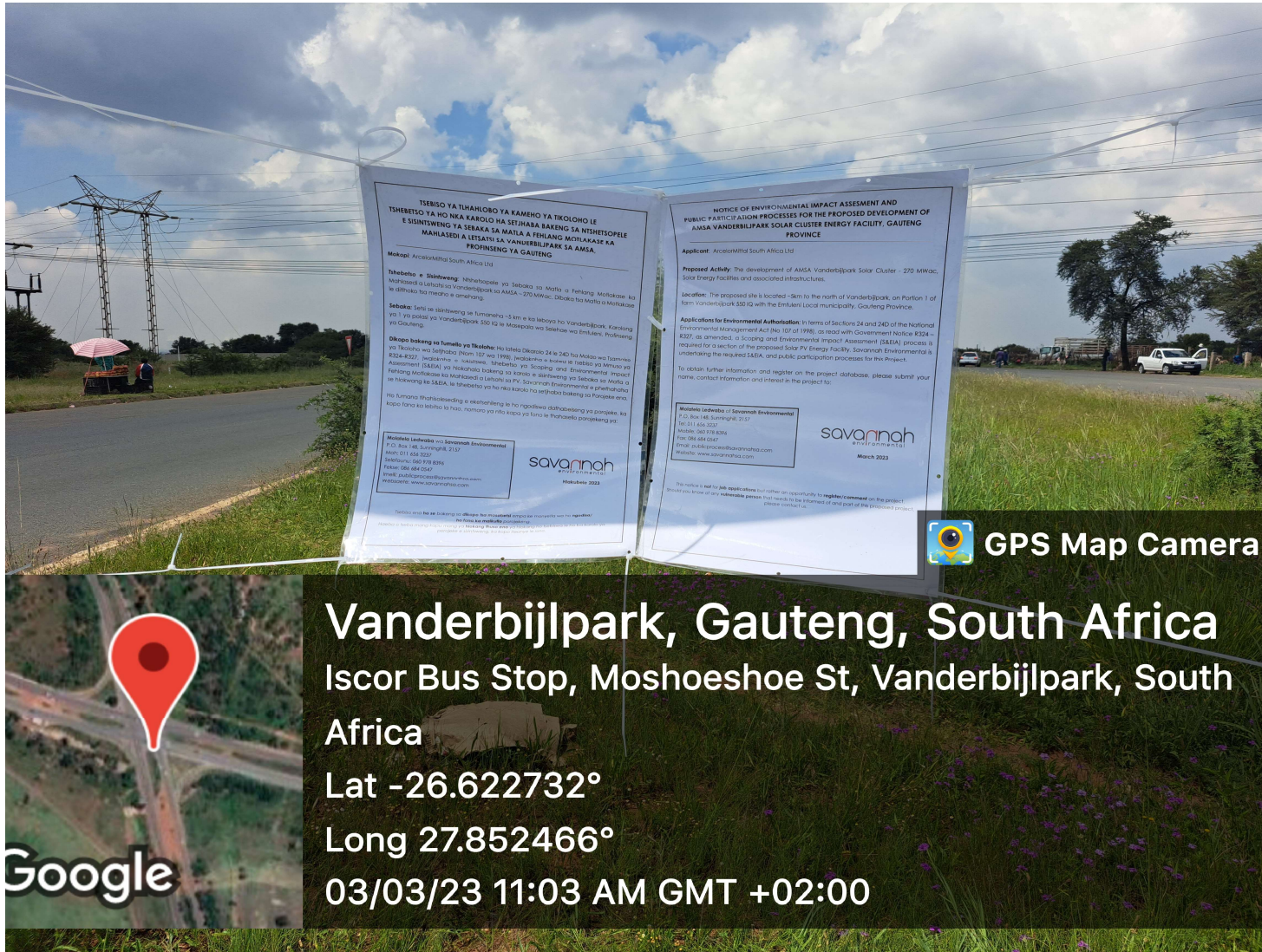

**Figure 1:** Site notices 1 (English and Sesotho) placed on corner Frikkie Meyer Boulevard and Moshoeshoe street

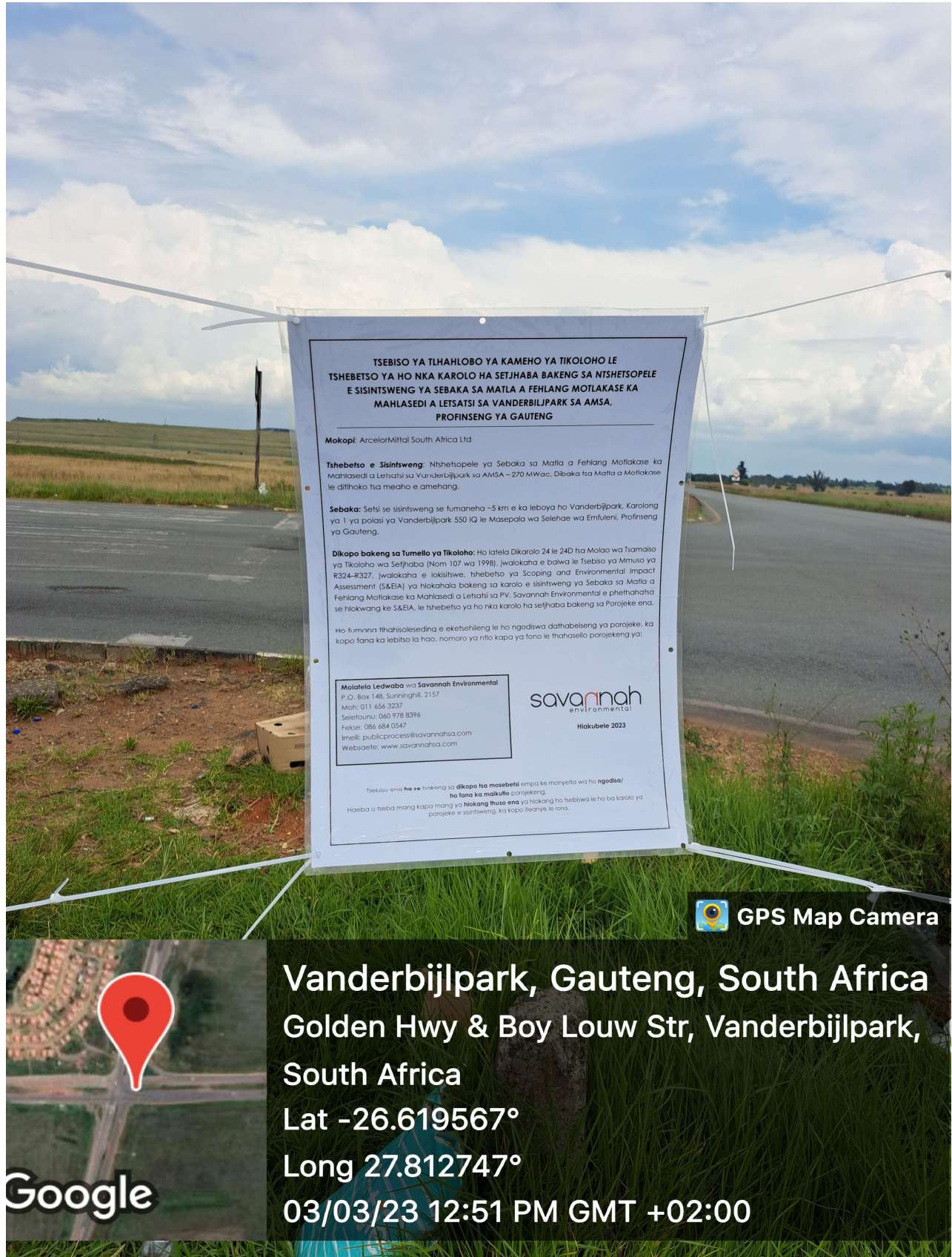


Figure 2: Site notice 2 (Sesotho) placed at a crossroads, corner R28 and R54

It won't be an easy feat, though, as Netball South Africa have 22 contracted players who will make up the core of the national team.

The Telkom Netball League has certainly grown since it began in 2014, where the Free State Cinnams were the inaugural winners. They went on to dominate the league, and won the title three years in a row.

It was then the turn of the Gauteng Jaguars, who upstaged the Cinnams and went one one better to secure the championship for four consecutive years.

All eyes will be on SA captain Bongsi Msoi's team, the Gauteng Golden Fireballs.

They are the defending champions, and there is no doubt that the opposition will want to topple them this season.

The Jaguars, meanwhile, have Proteas duo Izette Griesel and Lungile Mthembu in their ranks. Griesel was part of the Jaguars team that lost in last year's final, so she and her teammates will want to go one

better in 2023.

It's no secret that the Gauteng teams have been the top performers in recent seasons.

Speaking to the media after the announcement that Telkom have extended their sponsorship with NSA for the next three years, Moloikwane body president Cecilia Moloikwane said she wants to see new champions, and believes there could be a surprise this time around.

Moloikwane may be right, as there are two new teams that were added to the league in the Lilies from Limpopo and Sonoblo from the Free State, which means the league has increased from 13 to 15 teams.

Western Cape side the Stings take on the Eastern Cape Aloes. The Stings have Nichole Taljaard, who most recently played for the Proteas during the Quad Series in February. The shooter will want to perfect her game as the World Cup edges closer.

The first leg of the event will start tomorrow and run until Monday at the Ngoako Ramathodi Sports Complex in Seshego, Polokwane.

The Telkom Netball League will resume with the second leg on 2 June at the Heartfelt Arena in Pretoria.

# Future of SA cricket heading to Sri Lanka

TONY de Zorzi will lead a 15-man SA 'A' touring squad to Sri Lanka, Cricket South Africa (CSA) revealed in a statement yesterday morning as part of the association's "overall strategy to increase the depth of players within its pipeline".

The team will play three one-day and two four-day matches against their island nation's counterparts, starting with a limited-overs encounter on June 4. Proteas Test coach Shukri Conrad will provide guidance from the dug-out.

Players that have been selected include the exciting Deward Brevis and Tristan Stubbs, both of whom have been touted as future megastars of the game. A handful of Test players will also travel along to Sri Lanka, including Keegan Petersen, Kyle Verreynne and Gerald Coetzee.

"The squad reflects the next crop of players that are emerging from our pipeline" Conrad said in the statement. "We also rewarded those who have performed for their respective domestic teams this past summer. The tour will provide the opportunity for those players, together with the younger Proteas, to put their skills to the test in highly competitive, international conditions.

"It will also serve to strengthen

# Zwane doesn't want Chiefs to give up on second place

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AFTER going down to Sekhukhune United last Sunday, Kaizer Chiefs slipped up in the race to finish second on the Premiership standings.

The setback has allowed rivals Orlando Pirates and SuperSport United to strengthen their efforts to finish runners-up to Mamelodi Sundowns, who have already won the league title.

A fourth-place spot seems to be the mostly likely finish for Chiefs, and to stay on course, they will need a beat relegation-doomed Chippa United tomorrow at Nelson Mandela Bay Stadium.

Chippa find themselves at the other end of the table, so their focus is on survival. They are in 15th place, and the relegation axe looms large. They (26 points) are one point above bottom side Maritzburg United (25).

In their last outing, Chippa played one of their better matches this season, but it was not enough to stop Sekhukhune from winning 2-1 in the quarter-finals of the Nedbank Cup.

If they can repeat that performance, it may be enough to topple Chiefs, who are going through a rocky patch.

Amakhosi coach Arthur Zwane is concerned about the availability of key player Keagan Dolly, who left the field injured in the second half against Sekhukhune.

Zwane has confirmed that Dolly is nursing a knee problem. If he does not pass a fitness test today, the coach is likely to call on Burundian Bonfils-Caleb Bimenyimana to take Dolly's place.

"We'll wait for the medical team for the report... then we'll take it from there," said Zwane.

Despite Sunday's setback, Zwane is still harbouring thoughts of a Caf Champions League slot next season.

"I'm one person who doesn't give up too easily. This is football, and anything can happen at any given time," said Zwane.

"We dropped points and, yes, I'm disappointed and I know we could have done better.

"It's one of those things where you never know what's going to happen, because everyone's fighting to be in the top eight or avoid relegation, and we're also fighting to be in a better position.

"There are no easy games at this time of the season."

Tomorrow's other league match will see third-from-bottom Swallows FC welcome Maritzburg United to Dobsonville Stadium.

Maritzburg are rock-bottom on the log, and coach Fadlu Davids has spent the past few days plotting their plan for the match.

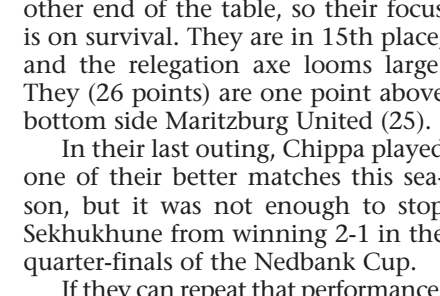
He flew down to Cape Town over the weekend to watch Swallows in action against Stellenbosch FC, and he would have seen enough to arm his players with a match-winning blueprint.

"It's not over (the relegation fight), it is not all lost. We play Swallows, we play Marumo Gallants - it's direct rivals, and it's still in our hands," said Davids.

"It's clear that we need six points from our next two games. But let us focus on the first one, and then the next one we will tackle, analyse and go through.

"But now, our focus is on Swallows. Getting three points against Swallows is so, so vital.

"We will take the same mentality, the same aggressive approach to win matches. If we need to create more, we will create more - because it is goals that are missing, especially after the way we unlocked Richards Bay in the first half and also the second half."
