Further to your letter reference:9/2/037/0001 of 20 June 2006 addressed to Old Seal  
South Africa: Prospecting on Portion 1-3 of the Farm 543; the Farm Grasvlakte 61,  
District of Hay, Northern Cape Region.

The initial phase of Old Seal South Africa prospecting will involve a mapping of those  
two areas, followed, if findings justify it, by drilling at target areas. As the heritage  
impact of this last mentioned activity is of very limited extend. I continue to ask, on  
behalf of Old Seal South Africa if this fact would justify a letter of exemption.

If so, a provision should be that any subsequent trenching or mining by Old Seal South  
Africa could have to be preceded by a phase 1 Heritage Impact Assessment.
