ARCHAEOLOGICAL INVESTIGATION OF KLEINRIVIER SHELTER

During the period under review a start was made with the cleaning and recording of the sections of the excavations at Kleinrivier Shelter. Special care was taken during the cleaning process to avoid possible damage of the walls. In general the deposit is very loose, soft and dry - it is a case of occupational dust carefully balanced on loose sterile grit and gravel lenses - some 2 m high, which could collapse with the touch of a brush. Most of the time only a blow brush was used to clean the walls. The recording will continue during the next few months.
