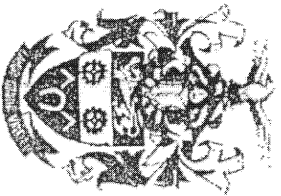

## PIETERSBURG SEWERAGE

Your fax dated 15 March 2000 has reference.

The area in question does not contain any archaeological or historical remains of significance, other than the remains of **NEW PIETERSBURG**. In respect of New Pietersburg I wish to quote a paragraph from a letter dated 30 September 1999 that was directed to the Pietersburg / Polokwane CEO from the National Monuments Council.

*"The TLC is requested not to allow any further development on any part of the whole of the old area known as New Pietersburg. The area is historically and culturally significant in the context of destruction of multiracial areas during the Apartheid era. The NMC requires an oral and written history survey in conjunction with an archaeological, photographic and Aerial survey of the area in question"*

On Wednesday 29 March 2000 I had a telephone discussion with the Assistant Regional Director of the NMC, Mr Ron Viney, and it is clear that this matter is regarded in a serious light. Due to the fact that this assessment had been requested on such short notice, Mr Viney proposes a meeting with relevant stakeholders on Monday, 10 April 2000.
