Executive summary

The purpose of the completed project was to exhume, relocate and re-inter forty-nine graves associated with the de Beer family from Portion 10 of the Farm Tygervallei 334 JR. The graves were situated in an area earmarked for development by D. Georgiades East Farm (Pty.) Ltd., who is also the landowner.

The family was identified through a process of social consultation, at the hand of inscriptions on headstones of the graves. The family was contacted and informed of the proposed development on the property, which would impact on the graves. The family assented to the exhumation, relocation and re-internment of the graves at Pretoria East Cemetery.

No recommendations regarding the future of the site has been made, since the site will be developed as a whole. All relevant information has been recorded and documented and is presented in this report.

The stakeholders identified during the social consultation and community participation processes are the de Beer family (represented by Mr. JS de Beer), the landowner and developer D. Georgiades East Farm (Pty.) Ltd. (represented by Mr. P Georgiades), and the Tshwane Metropolitan Council Department of Cemeteries (represented by Mr. A Deneyschen).




Location Maps

Scope of work

Social Consultation

A thorough process of social consultation has been instituted. The extant family members have been identified, and a representative appointed by them.

Two legal advertisements have been placed in the *Beeld* newspaper, in Afrikaans and English respectively. Furthermore, a notice has been affixed to the entry gate to the cemetery, dated 28 January 2006 (see Social Consultation Schedule).

The oldest living family member is Mrs. CW de Beer, whose son Mr. J de Beer acts as the family representative.

A first meeting was scheduled for 12 December 2005, where the family's needs and requirements were discussed. Various options were discussed, among these the possibility of re-internment at *Bronkhorstspuit Cemetery*. However, the family preferred reburial to take place at *Pretoria East Cemetery*. Mrs. CW de Beer also requested a provisional plot to be bought alongside her deceased husband at the new location (Grave TGV 04: Johannes Stefanus de Beer). All these requirements have been met and all costs covered by *D Georgiades East Farm (Pty.) Ltd*. In total fifty new grave stands will be purchased from the *Tshwane Metropolitan Council*, at *Pretoria East Cemetery*.

Agreements between *Archaic HPM* and the *Tshwane Metropolitan Council, Director: Cemeteries* have been reached where the fifty graves will form a separate section of the existing *Pretoria East Cemetery*. Part of the agreement stipulates that *Archaic HPM* is responsible for the erection of a wall around this area, in order to create a "memorial garden". Other than the single extra plot belonging to Mrs. De Beer, no other new burials will be allowed. Unfortunately, as part of the *Tshwane Metropolitan Council's* stipulations, only the headstones are allowed to be re-erected. This has been conveyed to the family, and has been agreed to. They are pleased to have their relatives' remains relocated to a public cemetery with unrestricted access and that will be maintained by the cemetery management.

Site description

The site comprises of an informal cemetery of the family *de Beer*. There are a total 49 graves, the oldest dated to 1897 and the most recent dated to 1974. The farm belonged to the *de Beer* family, and relatives by marriage, from at least the latter half of the 19th century, until the 1950's when it was sold by the deceased owner's second wife. The present family *de Beer* lost all rights and inheritance due to this sale, but were allowed by the subsequent owner to live on the property. The property was again sold during the 1970's, after which the family was prohibited access. The property belongs at present to *D. Georgiades East Farm (Pty.) Ltd.*, who is also the client requesting the exhumation, relocation and re-internment of the graves.

All graves in the cemetery comprise of either granite or slate headstones with names inscribed, except one. Of the 49 graves only seven do not have dates of either birth or death, and one grave has no visible inscriptions at all. The headstone of this grave (TGV 42), has been removed from the grave sometime in the past, and placed at the eastern boundary fence. The headstone is of cast concrete. The seven graves without dates all appear to be those of children, and according to the family they passed away during the 1930-1940's, and are thought to have died during the flu epidemic of that time. The graves' orientation is according to the standard Christian tradition, being east to west, with the headstones placed at the west.

Methodology

The methods employed during exhumation aimed to recover all the remains, to minimise damage to the remains, to record the three-dimensional context of the remains and to preserve and respect the dignity of the buried individual. All evidence that might allude to the events leading to the death of the individual and circumstances regarding the event were recorded and interpreted. The information gathered was presented in a technical report.

The excavation methods employed accomplished the in situ exposure of the burial and associated artefacts (Nienaber and Steyn, 1999). The focus was on accurate and complete documentation (Nienaber, 1977). Various methods for the excavation of graves have been proposed by different authors (Hester, 1975; Joukowsky, 1980; Krogman and Iscan, 1986; Morse, 1978) and all stress the need for adequate workspace around the exposed remains and a systematic approach to the removal of individual bones. The archaeological method, including extensive test trenching to prevent damage to the remains, was employed. This approach was largely similar to that of forensic archaeology where buried body cases are concerned. The approach was adapted for each situation since graves vary in shape, size, depth and content (Nienaber, 1999). The methods used in forensic archaeology are discussed by Steyn, et.al. (2000).

In each case, the surface features of the grave were cleaned and documented. A contractor specialising in the erecting of new grave dressings, and with some experience of demolishing and re-erecting existing grave dressings, was appointed to remove and re-erect the headstones. This was done under close supervision of the archaeologist. All observations regarding construction, materials and characteristics of the surface features were documented.

After the removal of the surface features the extent of the burial pit was ascertained through excavation and observation of differences in the matrix. After the indications of the presence and characteristics of the burial pit were documented, the in-fill was excavated to expose the human remains and associated cultural materials. Removal of the matrix of the burial pit was accomplished through the test-trench approach

whereby a narrow trench (25-30 cm wide) is excavated with a trowel to a depth of between 15 and 20 cm in the lower third of the burial pit (in this instance the lower third usually constituted the eastern side of the grave). This area is chosen since it is most likely that the femurs of the skeleton occur in this part of the grave. Since the femur is a robust bone, it is usually not easily damaged through excavation. If no indications of the presence of human remains are observed in the test trench the remaining in-fill matrix, down to the depth of the test trench, was removed with a shovel. The removed matrix was carefully screened to retrieve any possible cultural artefacts associated with the burial. This process was repeated until indications of the presence of human remains were observed.

As soon as human remains were encountered, care was taken to leave as much of the skeleton as possible covered in order to protect the remains from damage by excavation and to preserve the integrity of the context of the skeletal elements and possible associated cultural remains. The extent and characteristics of the burial pit were now documented and the workspace was assessed and enlarged if not sufficient. This was only done after documentation of the features of the burial pit and without sacrificing any vital information.

The excavation then continued with the aim of ascertaining the extent of the skeletal remains and the location of the different skeletal elements. As soon as the location and extent of the skeleton was established, a trench was dug around the remains so that the skeleton was enclosed in a low pedestal of matrix. The remains were then uncovered, starting from the middle and working outwards. This method again ensures the minimum disturbance of the remains and associated cultural materials. As soon as the skeleton was uncovered, it was documented in situ, removed, and packed

for analysis, where this was required. A further test trench of 15 cm deep was dug in the area directly underlying the location of the remains to ensure that all possible remains and artefacts were found and recovered.

The legal department of the Tshwane Metropolitan Council reached a decision which was conveyed to Archaic HPM on 24 January 2006, that the usual grave fees will apply, should the family be able to provide proof of residence within the Tshwane Metropolitan Council boundaries. This was agreed upon and the family was requested to provide Archaic HPM with amenity bills as proof.




Figure 18: TGV 06/601 Remains




Figure 20: TGV 07/602 Headstone detail




Figure 25: TGV 08/603 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 26: TGV 08/603 Remains




Figure 33: TGV 10/605 Remains




Figure 44: TGV 14/609 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 47: TGV 15/610 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 61: TGV 19/614 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 94: TGV 29/624 Detail of headstone




Figure 95: TGV 29/624 Grave pit, no remains found




Figure 97: TGV 30/625 Detail of headstone




Figure 107: TGV 33/628 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 113: TGV 36/631 Headstone and dressing




Figure 119: TGV 28/633 Headstone and dressing




Figure 128: TGV 41/636 Headstone and dressing




Figure 137: TGV 43/638 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 138: TGV 43/638 Remains




Figure 150: TGV 47/642 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 152: TGV 48/643 Headstone and dressing




Figure 156: TGV 49/644 Grave pit with tin above grave




Figure 157: TGV 49/644 No remains found
