PENGE BORROW PITS ARCHAEOLOGICAL SURVEY

As requested, we have investigated the location of the two proposed borrow pit sites at Penge, Sekhuhuneland district, Northern Province. The location of the sites was pointed out to us by members of the engineering company and centre around the following coordinates: S 24°20'40.3"; E 30°17'35.7"; S 24°21'41.8"; E 30°17'33.9". Both sites are located on the farm Streatham 100KT.

No sites, features or artifacts of cultural significance were identified on any of the sites and it is recommended that development can continue. However, it should be kept in mind that archaeological sites tend to occur below the ground. If, during construction, anything is opened up, this should be reported in order that it can be investigated further.
