**RE: REQUEST FOR HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT – PORTIONS OF THE FARM  
GROOTKUIL 376 KQ, THABAZIMBI, LIMPOPO PROVINCE – Ref: 9/2/274/0002**

Your letter dated 20 September 2007 has reference.

Archaeologists from MATAKOMA-ARM visited the area proposed for prospecting by Lumba Projects and have the following findings and recommendations:

1. The proposed prospecting consists of the sampling of geological anomalies located on the portions applied for. The sampling will consist of auguring, drilling and bulk sampling within the constraints of these anomalies.
2. None of the sampling sites are larger than 200m<sup>2</sup>, and no work will be conducted outside of the boundaries of the anomalies.
3. Access to the drilling site will be via existing roads and fire breaks. No new roads will be made and no soil and vegetation adversely disturbed.


It is our opinion that the prospecting activity will have no effect on known and unknown heritage resources on the portions applied for.
