**RE: REQUEST FOR HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT – PORTION 1, 4, 5, 6, 7 AND 19
OF THE FARM MAROELASFONTEIN 366 KQ, THABAZIMBI, LIMPOPO PROVINCE –

Your letter dated 20 September 2007 has reference.

Archaeologists from MATAKOMA-ARM visited the area proposed for prospecting by Andalusite Resources and have the following findings and recommendations:

1. The proposed prospecting consists of the drilling of some 15 holes over the extent of the portions applied for.
2. Access to the drilling site will be via existing roads and fire breaks. No new roads will be made and no soil and vegetation adversely disturbed.
3. The area of impacts for drilling will be less than 100m², and these sites can be relocated where graves have been identified in the area.
4. No drilling will be done closer than 20 metres from graves on site.


It is our opinion that the prospecting activity will have no effect on known and unknown heritage resources on the portions applied for.
