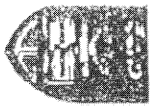

The ACO team searched the above site today. Excluding the built environment, which has been assessed by Mr H Alkman, we have encountered no factors that would cause any restrictions to development.

Small-dispersed quantities of Early Stone Age material (Flakes and irregular cores) were found among the stones. However, all of these are in a highly disturbed context (landscaping and ploughing) and do not require any further mitigatory measures.
