1. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

Transnet Group Capital has appointed Mbofho Consulting and Project Managers (MCPM) for the following task:

THE SWAZI RAIL LINK PROJECT – EXHUMATION AND RELOCATION OF GRAVES ON NEWSTEAD FARM NEAR LOTHAIR IN THE MSUKALIGWA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, MPUMALANGA PROVINCE

Transnet SOC Limited (hereafter referred to as Transnet) is a government (state) owned company (SOC) and is the custodian of South Africa's railway, ports and pipelines, thereby responsible for delivering reliable freight transport and handling services that satisfy customer demand. Transnet in collaboration with Swaziland Railway identified the construction and upgrade of the railway line between Davel in Mpumalanga and Richards Bay in KwaZulu- Natal, connecting via the Swaziland rail network, as a strategic project. The aim of the project is to unlock the potential of a multinational strategic rail corridor and divert general freight traffic off the dedicated heavy haul Richards Bay coal line which runs from Ermelo through rural Kwa-Zulu Natal to Richards Bay.

The project scope of work consists of various streams of work, including the upgrading of existing railway sections and construction of an entirely new rail link from Lothair (RSA) to Sidvokodvo in Swaziland.

The proposed development has necessitated the relocation of forty-three (43) graves located on the farm Bloemkrans Portion 12 on the outskirts of Lothair (26°23'52.50"S, 30°25'27.00"E). The exhumed remains will be reinterred at the municipal cemetery in Silindile Township (26°23'51.93"S, 30°27'16.85"E).

2. STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

A comprehensive situation analysis has been conducted relying heavily on a public participation process. As already stated the burial ground on the Farm Bloemkrans Portion 12 holds 43 individuals. Four families have been identified represented by Ms Regina Mathebula (11 graves)¹, Ms Tobina Nkosi (16 graves)², Ms Becrosbe Ngwenya (1 grave), and Ms Thoko Zwane (3 graves) together accounting for thirty-one (31) graves. Of these nine (9) graves are more than 60 years old and require SAHRA permitting in terms of Section 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act for their relocation (Thoko Zwane = 3 graves, Regina Mathebula = 3 graves, Msesi Simelane = 2; and Zodwa Nkosi = 1). Besides the 31 graves that have been identified there are twelve (12) other graves which have not been claimed suggesting that they are older possibly more than 60 years old. This has entailed the Msukaligwa Local Municipality to act as custodian of the graves for purposes of the SAHRA permitting. A letter of commitment by the local Municipality is therefore attached to the health permit application. South African Resources Agency permitting in terms of Section 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act (No 25 / 1999) will be applied for in respect these


graves, which brings the total of graves to be covered by the permit to **twenty-one** (21).






THOKO ZWANE / ZWELIBANZI NKOSI 02





