Walls are rusticated.

Verandah along the whole front with concave roof, ornamental fretwork and wooden posts. Flag rail.

Entrance is glazed and modern, but also half-glazed double doors with 2 pane fanlights.

The splayed wings have Edwardian type casement windows. Also small square casement windows between doors.

High Edwardian(?) chimneys. Fine C.I. fence and gates along street. Palms and Falkland pines in front.
