WAYLEAVE APPLICATION FOR SERVICES: WATER PIPE LINE – REIGER PARK, BOKSBURG.

Your letter dated 18 January 2019 refers.

The following Eskom distribution services are affected

- Central Vertical/Far East Vertical HV 88kV Feeder Overhead Power line
- Angelo/Germiston Factories HV 44kV Feeder Overhead Power line

The approximate position of these services is indicated on the attached drawing. Please note that the exact position of these services cannot be guaranteed.

Eskom will raise no objection to this application provided it's rights and services are acknowledged and respected at all times, and the requirements as laid down by the Occupational Health and Safety Act No 85/1993, are complied with. As additional safety measures Eskom require that the following conditions are complied with:

- 1. The applicant or his contractor must notify Eskom Germiston Service Centre-Contact person Mr. Sam Rudman 011 871 3060 email address: RudmanFS@eskom.co.za at least 14 days prior to the commencement of any work whatsoever, under or in close proximity to Eskom services.
- 2. The consent is further subject to the Landowner's permission for the proposed works as per this application. A copy of the permission must be filed with Eskom seven days before any work is carried out in the servitude area.
- 3. Please note that, under no circumstances will any relocation work proceed prior to the submission of a formal application to Eskom Customer Services and acceptance of the relocation costs by the applicant. A formal application for the relocation of Eskom services must be submitted at least three months prior to the commencement of any construction work
- 4. Any cost and claims due to interruptions or interference to Eskom services causing power supply loss or loss of income, due to this application, will be borne by the applicant.

- 5. Statutory clearances are to be maintained at all times. If Eskom has to incur any costs to comply with statutory requirements because of your work or the presence of your equipment then you will refund Eskom such proven costs on demand.
- 6. Eskom must have ingress to and egress from its services at all times.
- 7. No mechanical equipment, including mechanical excavators, may be used under or in close proximity to Eskom's services without the prior approval of Eskom's authorized representatives.
- 8. The use of explosives of any type within 500 meters of Eskom's services shall only occur with Eskom's previous written permission. If such permission is granted the applicant must give at least fourteen working days prior notice of the commencement of blasting. This allows time for arrangements to be made for supervision and/or precautionary instructions to be issued in terms of the blasting process.
- 9. Eskom shall not be liable for the death of or injury to any person or for the loss of or damage to any property caused in whatsoever manner by the applicant, his employees, agents or contractors. The applicant indemnifies Eskom against all claims including claims for consequential damages by third parties which includes but is not limited to claims as a result of damage to, or interruption of or interference with Eskom's services or equipment. The applicant's attention is drawn to section 27(3) of the Electricity Act 1987.
- 10. No excavations may be executed closer than 3 meters from any of Eskom underground electric power cables and 10 meters from Eskom overhead electrical power lines unless Eskom authorized representative is on site.
- 11. Equipment shall be regarded electrically live and therefore dangerous at all times.
- 12. No dumping shall be allowed in the servitude area.
- 13. No squatting to be allowed in the servitude area.
- 14. Eskom may stipulate any additional requirements to illuminate any possible exposure to Customers of Public to coming into contact or be exposed to any dangers of Eskom plant.
- 15. The contractor in charge of the construction or maintenance work on site must at all times be in possession of the letter of approval of the services concerned, and as well as all plans that are required and that are referred to in the correspondence, so that during an inspection the contractor can present the documentation to Eskom official(s) when requested to do so. If no approval is presented, then the Eskom Official(s) can order the work to be ceased until approval can be presented.
- 16. We have no record of our low voltage services in this Department and these will be indicated on site by Eskom Technical Services Officer mentioned in our conditions.
- 17. This wayleave is only valid for six months due to the constant infrastructure development over the area. If construction is over the six month period, a re-application must be submitted
- 18. Should the applicant or his contractor damage any of Eskom's services during commencement of any work whatsoever, then Eskom's 24 hour Fault number 011 800 4441 must be dialed immediately to report the incident
