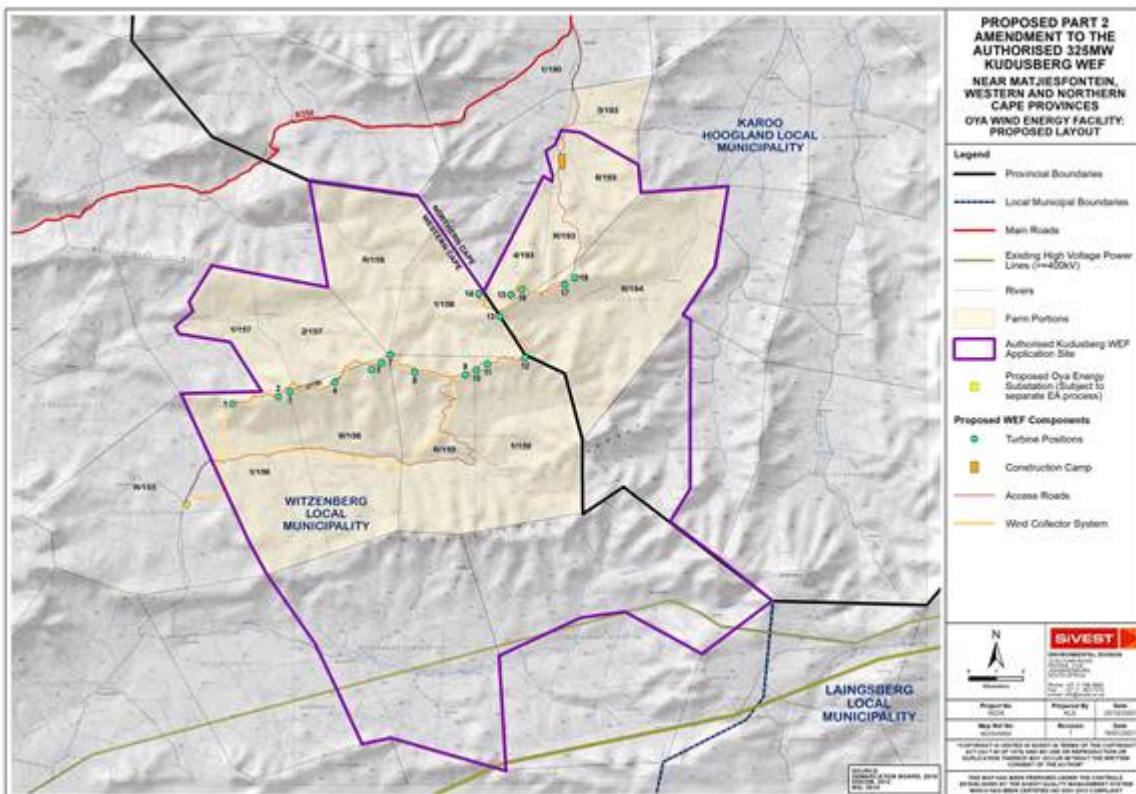

The roads will be maintained (re-gravelled) during construction and operation but will not be widened and as such do not trigger any listed Activity under the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA): Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2014 as amended.
