PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE LAYOUT OF THE OYA WEF AS PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY

HWC AND SAHRA (CASE NO. 15789)

Kudusberg Wind Farm (Pty) Ltd (hereafter referred to as "Kudusberg Wind Farm") was issued

with an Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the proposed construction of the 325MW Kudusberg

Wind Energy Facility (WEF) and associated infrastructure, between Matjiesfontein and Sutherland

in the Western and Northern Cape Provinces. The EA was granted on 25 March 2019 (DEFF

Reference No.: 14/12/16/3/3/1/1976, and subsequently amended on 04 April 2019 to correct a

minor naming error (14/12/16/3/3/1/1976/AM1). The EA was granted subsequent to the approval

of the proposed Kudusberg WEF by both Heritage Western Cape (for the sections of the project

within the Western Cape) and SAHRA (for the sections of the project within the Northern Cape).

Kudusberg Wind Farm is now proposing to submit a Part 2 EA Amendment Application to split the

authorised Kudusberg WEF (14/12/16/3/3/1/1976/AM1) into two (2) separate smaller WEF

projects, namely the Kudusberg WEF and Oya WEF, which result in a number of technical and

administrative changes. The split is being proposed to allow the projects to be suitable for

numerous opportunities such as either the Renewable Energy Independent Power Producer

Procurement Programme (REIPPPP), Risk Mitigation Independent Power Producer Procurement

Programme (RMIPPPP), other government run procurement programmes that may arise or for

sale to private entities, if enabled and/or required in the drive for energy security in South Africa.

Following the split, the northern section of the authorised WEF will become the Oya WEF, while the

southern section of the authorised WEF will remain known as the Kudusberg WEF (authorised

under 14/12/16/3/3/1/1976/AM1). The final layout for the Oya WEF has been subject to a detailed

specialist walk-through and on site micro-siting as per condition 29 of the Kudusberg EA. CTS

Heritage completed the required Final Walkdown of the Oya WEF and developed the Heritage

Management Plan for the Oya WEF. Both of these reports (the Final Walkdown Report and the

Heritage Management Plan for the Oya WEF) were submitted to HWC and SAHRA for approval in

November 2020. The submitted reports were approved by both HWC and SAHRA in December

2020 (attached).






Figure 1: Final Layout for the Oya WEF as per the approved Walkdown Report and HMP

Subsequent to this approval, G7 supplied an amended layout to the proposed WEF, removing turbines 2 and 6 in Figure 1 above. In addition, the following amendments to the project description also apply:




Figure 2: Amended Final Layout for the Oya WEF

This letter thereby serves to confirm that the refined layout related to the Oya WEF (dated January 2021) has no material change on the assessment, findings, impacts (including nature, significance and mitigation measures) and recommendations of the specialist reports including



the completed and approved Final Walkdown Report and Heritage Management Plan. From a heritage perspective, the results are identical and the change in location has no material effect on the specialist assessment conducted for the project. The recommendations and findings of the reports therefore apply without modification to the refined layout as indicated below in Figure 2.
