RE: HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT: CONSULTATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 40 OF THE MINERAL AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2002, (ACT NO 28 OF 2002) FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN IN RESPECT OF A PORTION OF THE REMAINING EXTENT OF WARM ZAND 468, ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT: KEIMOOES

With reference to the letter received from SAHRA on the 26th of February 2013, Greenmined would herewith like to submit a Heritage Site Assessment (HAS) of the mining area on the farm Warm Zand 468 (Friarsdale). The HAS was conducted during the first mining permit application on the farm. The applicant, Afrimat Aggregates Limited, has applied for a second mining permit (NCS30/5/1/3/2/10158MP) in the vicinity of the approved quarry area. The proposed mining area does however fall into the area surveyed by the archaeologist during the first site inspection.

During the assessment the archaeologist identified a single stone lined structure (See figure 4 of the assessment report). As the specialist concluded that the alignment and shape of the structure indicates a possible grave the site has been identified as having a high heritage significance and a buffer area of 10m has been defined around the possible grave site to ensure its protection. Please see the position of the possible grave area in relation to the proposed mining area as indicated on the attached site map.
