REVISED LAYOUT OF NAMIES WEF – HERITAGE COMMENT

Thank you for sending details of the revised Namies WEF layout. The new layouts are satisfactory in heritage terms in that they create a larger buffer around the sensitive Namies village area and because no red flags were identified during the survey.

However, because archaeological resources are point-specific, it will be required that a walk-down survey should be carried out prior to construction to check whether any further mitigation-worthy archaeological resources are present within the newly proposed development footprint. Given what we know of the area, it is extremely unlikely that any further red flags would be found and if any archaeology requiring mitigation were to be located it is envisaged that this would be very easily accomplished.

As such, the project may proceed as planned but subject to the walk-down survey as noted above.
