EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Rooitop Ontwikkelings Orania (Pty)Ltd intends developing a residential area on portion 46 of farm 272 located east of Orania.

The aim of the study is to determine the localities of archaeological, historical and other cultural remains in relation to the proposed developments and to assess the impact of the developments on it.

The local importance of prehistoric engravings in the footprint area, is sufficient to recommend that part of the area be retained as a heritage site. The Stone Age artifacts found were not in context and is of low significance.

It is recommended that the proposed development proceed.

1. INTRODUCTION

Rooitop Ontwikkeling Orania (Pty)Ltd intends the developing of a residential area on portion 46 of farm 272. A heritage impact study is required and Shangoni Management Services (Pty)Ltd was contracted. This report is done in terms of the National heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999) and will be part of the EIA.

2. STUDY METHODOLOGY

The area (27.25ha) was investigated on foot over a 3 day period. Observations and finds were plotted on maps (GIS format) (decimal degrees) by GPS and recorded on camera.

Note was taken of previous archaeological studies in Orania by Opperman (2012, 2013a, 2013b, 2016, 2017, 2021)

3. LOCALITIES (ANNEXURES A,B)

The area for the Rooitop development lies east of Orania and north of the "servitude" dirt road that passes through Orania.

The vegetation is Xhariep Karroid Grassland and Northern Upper Karroo (Eysel 2022) with trees and shrubs.

Dolerite rocks occur in outcrops and ridges with an east west orientation.

4. RECORDED FINDINGS

A total of 16 engravings, graffiti and prehistoric stone artifacts were recorded. Because of age and patination some engravings especially fine line ones, became difficult to see and photograph. They are described as unidentified.

5. ASSESMENT OF IMPACT

Prehistoric engravings, graffiti and Stone Age artifacts were found. Residential development will negatively influence the engravings.

6. MITIGATION

A conservation plan must be drawn up for the protection of the archaeological heritage materials in footprint area portion 46.

7. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that, depending on the findings of other specialists, the proposed developments may proceed. The construction process should be monitored for the appearance of archaeological remains not observed during this study.








1. Vegetation portion 46
