#### B. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Eskom plans a new power line to replace an existing power line south of Ermelo. The Highveld region is poor on archaeological sites. Some Late Iron Age sites occur northwest of Ermelo at Tafelkop.

The town of Ermelo was destroyed during the Anglo Boer War as well as all farmhouses. The area had to be rebuilt after the war.

Two possible routes for the power line were investigated.

Route 1 follows the route of two existing power lines to the east of the town mainly following existing water courses and then turns southwest to the substation near Camden Power Station.

No important cultural heritage recourses were found near this route.

Route 2 firstly follows two existing power lines and then turns south and east following another power line route across a mining area and just north of Camden Power Station to the substation.

There is no objection to the construction of either of the two power lines from a cultural heritage point of view.

# D. BACKGROUND TO THE ARCHAEOLOGY AND HISTORY OF THE AREA.

The proposed new power lines will run through Highveld grassland. The Highveld was to a large degree avoided by early people because there was no wood available for fire making and building. The archaeological database of the National Museum for Cultural History is Pretoria has no archaeological data on the area south of Ermelo. The nearest Late Iron Age sites are early Sotho sites on Tafelkop some twelve kilometres north west of Ermelo. These were the so-called Leghoya and were associated with the stone huts which mainly occur in the north-eastern Free State (Mason R 1962, pp385 and Maggs TM 1972, pp54 – 65) (GPS S26° 27' 35.18 & E29° 48' 32.71")


Ermelo was founded by the Dutch Reformed Churches reverent Frans Leon Cachet. He named the settlement Ermelo after a town in the Netherlands where Hermanus Willem Witreveen lived, which had a great influence on Cachets life. A congregation was started at Ermelo in 1870.

The town developed at a steady pace as it was on the wagon route between Durban and the Eastern Transvaal Goldfields. Halfway between Ermelo and Amersfoort is the beautiful sandstone bridge known as "Begin der Lijbrug" over the Vaal River. This name comes from the fact that the original border fence between the ZAR and Swaziland started here. The bridge was inaugurated on the 12<sup>th</sup> April 1898 and declared a National Monument in 1955 (Oberholster JJ 1972, p329 and Transvaal Archive records) – see photograph.

During the Anglo Boer War the town was totally destroyed with only one house surviving. The same happened to Boer farmhouses in the district. After the war the town was totally rebuilt (Erasmus BP 2004, p302). One of the oldest buildings in the town which is about 500 metres from the new proposed power line route is the old Prison built in 1903 with sandstone. The building was in use till 1990 (Lombard RTJ 1980, p26).

#### (b) Description of methodology

#### (i) How the area was searched

The site was visited for one full day together with the Environmental Consultants specialists as well as all the other environmental specialists including staff of Eskom. The two possible routes were travelled by vehicle and also inspected on foot. The proposed new power lines will follow to a large degree the route of an existing power line which will be demolished.

The town itself was visited to collect historic data and to visit one of the oldest surviving buildings the 1903 Prison. Literature on the town's history was searched at the local library and on History on line.

A detail Google search was done on the proposed routes of the line as any human disturbance in grassland can easily be found on Google images. The Archaeological database of the National Museum of Cultural History is Pretoria was also visited.

#### (ii) Restrictions to the study area

It was quite easy to follow the first section of the route as it follows an existing line. Line option 1 continues along an excising line while option 2 deviated from the present line to the south. This section's route goes over an intensively mined area where the surface has been totally depleted through mining activities. It also has exotic vegetation over large areas. The line option 2 will also cross a very wet area.

## (iii)Data acquired

G.P.S. readings were taken at each bend in the proposed routes. Photographs were taken of the area as well as a nearby old farm settlement.

## F. DESCRIPTION OF SITES IDENTIFIED AND MAPPED

As already mentioned two possible routes were investigated.

#### Route 1

The line starts at  $S26^{\circ}$  30' 42.48" &  $E29^{\circ}$  58' 44.07" and runs southwards through a section of Ermelo town and uphill near a stream to cross the watershed and then downwards a valley near a stream to  $S26^{\circ}$  36' 04.77" &  $E30^{\circ}$  06' 51.90". From here it turns south to end at a substation near Camden power station at  $S26^{\circ}$  37' 03.74 &  $E30^{\circ}$  05' 46.21" – see photographs.

Once the new power line has been constructed the existing power line will be demolished as the poles of the old line are badly corroded. Another problem of this line is that it mainly follows existing water runoff areas which are not allowed any more from an environmental point of view.

No important heritage sites were found near route one. The nearest possible heritage site is 500 metres north of the line. It is a 1940's farm settlement with a gabled farmhouse – see photograph.

#### Route 2

This route follows the same existing power line to the east of Ermelo as Route 1. At  $S26^{\circ}$  33' 11.16" &  $E30^{\circ}$  04' 17.64" the proposed route bends south on a new route firstly along the border of a maize field and crosses the N2 road to Piet Retief (Mkonto). From here it crosses a depleted mining area up to  $S26^{\circ}$  34' 53.05" &  $E30^{\circ}$  03' 01.66" to continue southwards along the route of an existing power line to the substation at  $S26^{\circ}$  37' 03.74" &  $E30^{\circ}$  05' 46.21" – see photographs.

No important heritage sites could be found near route 2.

No heritage sites were found during the survey. There is no objection to the construction of any one of the two routes from a cultural heritage resources point of view.

If during construction any cultural heritage resources or graves are unearthed all work has to be stopped until the site has been inspected and mitigated by a cultural heritage practitioner.


