- **Johann:** With regards to the day of the Mandela Marathon, he requested a meeting outside of the PSC where we can align the Marathon Layout with the Project implementation proposal for the day. The meeting has now been confirmed for 10am tomorrow 14/07/2017
- **Sipho Ntuli:** pointed out the issue of the school exams being disturbed in the implementation or construction stage.
- **Oscar Dlomo:** Having guided Tourists on the Tourism route for years, the Izibukezulu high school principal and governing body have previously requested that the school have a hall constructed for them as they do have open space at the back of the Manaye Hall.
 - In including the historical aspect, he requests that the theme of this development moves away from Nelson Mandela's imprisonment however we should include the All in Africa Conference, the past Indian society, and incorporate the local history of the Manaye Hall specifically which will also speak to the local community and encourage ownership of this development.
 - The project should incorporate the different historical/ struggle legends that form the rich history of the greater Edendale and Pietermaritzburg.
 - There is different types of tourists, passer-bys and those who'll go into the centre and experience it. The project needs to be mindful of this.
- **Sipho Ntuli:** UMgungundlovu District at this point has the Nelson Mandela Capture site which focuses on Mandela's imprisonment and life in and after prison. In the Eastern Cape they have a museum which focuses on his childhood. We need to avoid having a duplication in terms of interpretation centres. The Mandela Foundation has previously requested that when the Manaye Hall takes off and is refurbished that it rather focus on the legends Political life.
- **Oscar Dlomo:** there's a need to rename the development, consider the liberation heritage the area boasts of and the different names that were given to Mandela which spoke of him as a political icon.
- **Ntombifuthi Buthelezi:** the provision of the school hall cannot be made the Municipalities responsibility. The Department of Education has been called in to be part of the stakeholders for such reasons, they need to intervene.
 - The project team [stakeholders, project manager and municipality] need to be realistic in terms of the figures required to implement the project.
 - District and Local Municipality to come together on the project, and be a united front in terms of the project.
 - The informal settlements on Sutherlands road need to be attended to at the early stages of the project by the Municipality.
- **SIYAKALA:** in response to the figures provided having to be realistic it was assured that the consultant and subs are well experienced with huge developments and they assure that

provisions for over and under budgeting will be made as well as over and under expenditure...all this will definitely be kept in mind

- **Sipho Ntuli:** raised concern on the limitation of space on the site, where we need to avoid wasteful expenditure in the implementing of the different phases. Requested the Municipality to confirm the ownership of the site.
- **Arts & Culture:** in response to the Sports field nearby the site, they advised that the Sports & Recreation department be invited to the meetings going forward.

A resolution was taken by the PSC that the Amphitheater be implemented as the first phase, in consultation with the Mandela Marathon.
