
- New Book for this quadrant since no book was filled in 2016 for this quadrant.
- Removed photo layer and cleaning of the three quadrants. The cleaning and the working have yielded no remains.
 - In particular cleaning has removed lead three once in the quadrant, a central block and a white one orange on the two opposite corners. The block off as above the other two and was removed first.
 - Following a change in the nomenclature of the layers it was given the name BLACK E EARL
 - After Downline cleaning of the section it appears that the top layer is in fact the WHITE, called WHITE EDGE, that at the base of the WHITE there is a thin orange layer, found on in the opposite corner of the quadrant, and that the brown is the lower one. At the lowest point of the brown appears on a tiny spot a grass mat, below the brown.

7th of May

Work starts later because of the unavailability of the one, remaining of the wood licks. I keep excavating the WHITE EDEAR. Three plows with recording of object are done. The excavation of the WHITE EDEAR shows that below it a thin layer of burnt bunches separate it from another white layer and that the distance is more complex than described yesterday. There is at the center of the ground a black layer coincided with the burnt branches which is on top of the orange. We are going to excavate that layer first. We will call it DARK BROWN VERY VERY DEVE.

8th of May 2012

The very VERY DARK BROWN DEVE has been almost completely removed the 7th of MAY. It has revealed that the white small spot are the section (see figure is located above and below the orange).



We first excavate the objects at the bottom of the Very Dark BROWN DEVE. THEN we excavate the white, which is called YELLOWISH BROWN DILION. Inside there grey color we find little fragments and two larger fragments of shaly bone. We finish the excavation of YELLOWISH BROWN DILION AT 12:00. This leaves exposed a section with the orange layer, below the yellowish brown DILION. The orange is higher on one side of the quadrant and we clear

to lower this one first.



the orange layer is called DARK GRAY (4/1) DEB1 after checking the colour with the Tweed cloth.

9/5/2017

Objects from the left side of the orange layer DARK GRAY DEB1 were removed at the end of day but some material belonging to this layer is still present on the square and is going to be removed during the morning. Some more objects are found at the very contact between the DARK GRAY (4/1) DEB1 and the following layer DARK BROWN and consolidated. The name DARK GRAY from the name given to it in 2016.

10/5/2017

excavation continues with removal of the DARK BROWN on the left side of the quadrant. Since since I also take coordinates for everybody below layer DARK BROWN there is a grass mat, also unusable on the north side of the square, much thicker on the south side.

11/5/2017

We move to PLAN 2, in which we find a porous grey and a fragment of skull, perhaps of porcupine. A bit of brown layer still present on the left and right side of the square. We are going to remove them during the morning. The grass mat below the dark brown appears clearly at the center of the square.

12/5/2017

Worked was delayed till 11/5/2017 by allowing the action and clearing of the quadrant done after the clearing finished at the beginning of the morning of the 12/5/2017. We remove the remainder of DARK BROWN on the right (EAST) side of the quadrant.

WE start the excavation of the green mat present at the center of the green mat previously in the SOUTH WEST corner. It is called GREYSH NAT DECON.


13/5/2017

The green mat on the SOUTH WEST corner and center of the quadrant was removed. This revealed a ash by area located at the center of the quadrant still containing some fibers we excavate this first.

Once finished and ash layer appears below. The green mat, covered by small white packing granules (gypsum crystals extend?) under in big charcoal. This layer extend between the center and the NORTH of the green. It is called GREYSH BROWN DIGBY and we start it removed, which reveals a big charcoal, coardest.

14/5/2017

We continue removing GREYSH BROWN DIGBY and move to Dylon 2.



is present in both X117.5 Y109 and X118 Y109 at its base there is a thin layer of dark brown layer follow by a light brown reddish layer. Expansion all over the two quadrants.

15/5/2017

We remove a large part of the GREYSH BROWN DIGBY. In the middle of it we find a very large roof shed. Remaining this layer reveal a concavity amongst the section.



The removal of GREYSH BROWN DIGBY AND DARK BROWN DYON REVEAL IN SECTION a layer, a combustor feature present for just


two-three centimeter in the quadrant

 at 12:00 and move to X118 Y109.

 Following previous excavation by Charles
 we stop from DARK YELLOWISH BROWN
 DINO PLAN 2

16/5/2017

WE remove in the morning the DARK YELLOWISH
 BROWN DINO PLAN 3. No detectable change of
 colour is observed except from small patches
 slightly more brown red tint. Several shingle box
 appear in the form of yellow powder. Our GZ
 is consolidated with powder and consolidated.
 At 11 am we start removing the Plan 4

WE then start removing the DARK BROWN DINO PLAN
~~4~~ which is a layer full of small fragments
 of wood well preserved 0.5 cm in diameter
 one little and a 25cm long stick made of wood
 that was consolidated to be removed only
 at the base of DARK BROWN
 DINO PLAN 1, on a small area,

017/5/2017

We call the whitish layer LIGHT BROWN DOG PLAN 1 and underneath We then remove Plan 2. A bit of Green Mat appears at the bottom of the concavity holding the brown and the whitish layer.

18/5/2017

After removing the LIGHT BROWN DOG PLAN 1 we start reworking on the whole surface and particularly the north side and the west side. We call the new layer DARK YELLOWISH BROWN DOG 1.

19/5/2017.

at the end of the day 19/5/2017 it was disrupted in the quadrant a possible burner (see plan attached to it). After discussion it was decided to keep the rest of eastward in the 10cm wide channel separate and leave it as a deposit unit. Nothing was found inside spots charcoal. The excavation of the burner was

Completed by 10:30.

We then removed a layer of YELLOWISH BROWN DOG PLAN 1. This revealed three areas close to the NORTH section and at the center of the quadrant with remnants of combustion features ~~and~~ with in dark red soil and a bit of white soil at the top a number of little red whitish in the YB DOG

20/5/2017

We remove a YELLOWISH BROWN DOG PLAN 2 and 3, basically to clean the quadrants and recover the lithics. We then move to the excavation of the remnant of the combustion features, one of which still contains a large block. This layer, which extends only in the small spots, is called VERY DARK BROWN DCD1.

21/5/2017

the removal of the remainder of the VERY DARK BROWN DCD1 yields a grassmat present. The SOUTH and BENTRAL part of the quadrants a thin layer of charcoal and, at places, little

White pellets (gypsum?) caking in the plan
 We first remove the white layer composed of
 the charcoal and white pellets close to the
 SOUTH border of the quadrant.

We have then cleaned the grass mat by
 pulling it. This has shown that the grass
 mat is located below the YELLOWISH
 BROWN in the neighboring quadrant X1175 Y109.
 We have moved to this last quadrant in order
 to remove YELLOWISH BROWN AND
 explore the grass mat on all its extension.

22/5/2012

A discharge of DARK YELLOWISH BROWN
 DOSSY PLAN 5 was removed at the end of
 the 21th. We now move to plan 5 in the
 X117.5 Y109. During the 22th we remove
 plan 6 on the WEST side of the quadrant.

23/5/2012


We remove plan 7 of the DARK YELLOWISH BROWN
 DOSSY, mostly in the WEST side of the
 quadrant

24/5/2012

We move to plan 8. The white ash below
 the DARK YELLOWISH BROWN DOSSY is
 already visible on half of the quadrant on its
 WEST SIDE. We then move to plan 9.

25/5/2012

The removal of PLAN 9 clarifies the situation.

26/5/2017

During this day we worked in
3BS with Quarry white too jackets were
made in X118 Y109 to sample the ground.
At the end of the day we worked on X117.5 Y109.

27/5/2017

The removal of a thin layer in the
SOUTH-EAST corner of X117.5 Y109 ~~shows~~ shows
that the white ash is the uppermost unit
followed by a black-dyed brown level which
is on top of a gessmud. There above a
Strong Brown layer, exposed on X118 Y109
by the making of the jackets. (See pages of
The White ash's excavated at the very ~~from~~
end of 26/5/2017 and we kept excavating
it the 27/5/2017 in X117.5 Y109.

28/5/2017

The layer ~~of~~ dark brown ash has
been taken out during this day. A piece

this plan.


29/5/2017

We remove the DARK BROWN DICE ON
the NORTH side of the square. This highlights the
orange/brown layer due to subsidence which is
removed as a separate layer, called, REDDISH
BROWN DICE.

We then identify a large area, still filled with
black material, belonging to the Dark Brown
DICE, which is taken in a separate bucket.
The removal of the DARK BROWN DICE EXPOSES
identifies a large irregular concavity.

30/5/2017

The quadrant X117.5 Y109 shows the following strata
in the morning of the 30th



with
filled the dark brown powder.
DURING The morning we first remove
the WHITE, then the dark brown below it and
we reach the light brown layer which are
all the quadrants, called STRONG BROWN
DIRTY PLAN 2. A large part of this layer is
removed in the SOUTH-EAST corner of the
quadrant. This layer is thick, about four
a block found close to the cemetery filled
with the DARK BROWN (previously removed)
The excavation of this square stop at the
end of the afternoon. The level reached on
the EAST side is the same present as the
neighboring square XII 8 y 109 when the STRONG
BROWN DIRTY is also exposed. 16:45.
