SAHRIS CaseID 16010:

Heritage Crime – Economic Freedom Fighters' (EFF) statements on the Day of Reconciliation, 16 December 2020, relating to the Battle of Blood River (1838) and associated historical events.

RE: Postponement of Requested Response Date by SAHRA / AMAFA to 13 May 2021

SAHRIS CaseID 16010 was reported to SAHRA / AMAFA on 22 January 2021; - the SAHRIS case pertaining to statements made by the Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) on the Day of Reconciliation, 16 December 2020, relating to the Battle of Blood River (1838) and associated historical events. ArchaeoMaps, in accordance with the National Heritage Resources Act, No. 25 of 1999 (NHRA 1999), and as per the submitted report, requested the inquiry for information to be addressed within three (3) calendar months from the date of submission, being 23 April 2021 (date on which SAHRA / AMAFA was to formally indicate whether or not the reported SAHRIS case will be further pursued by them in accordance with their mandate). No response was received by SAHRA / AMAFA.
