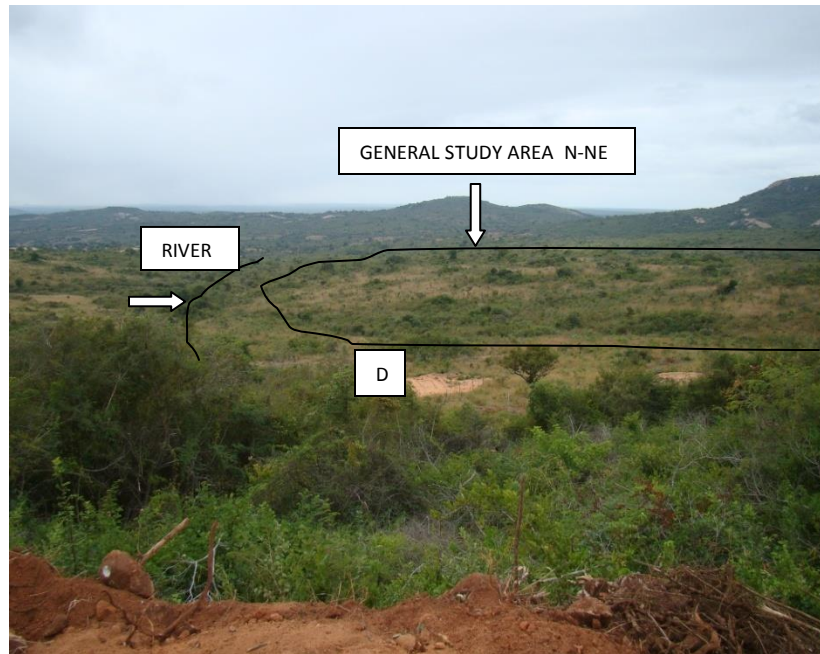


Fig. 1: The general study area as seen from the west. This includes the northern section.

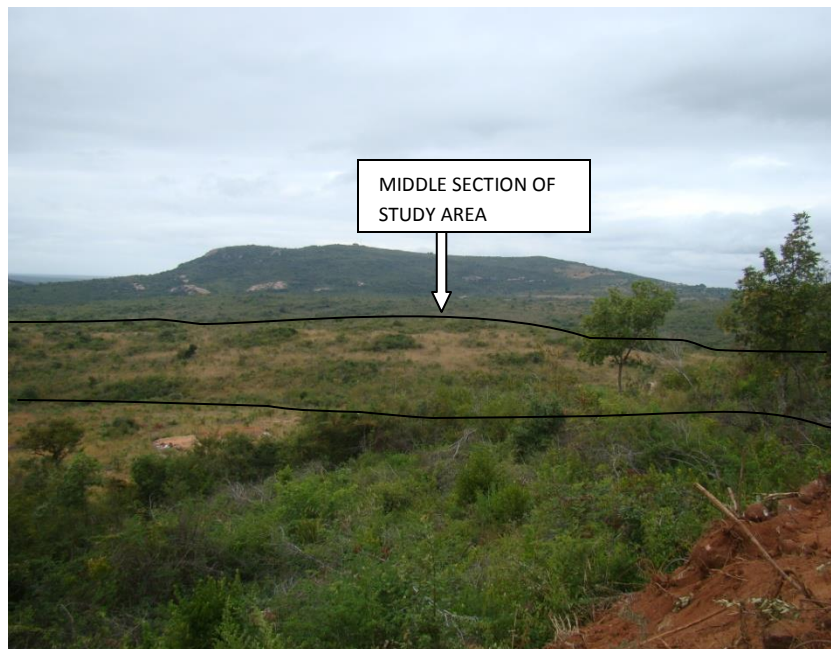


Fig. 2: The middle and south end section of the study area.

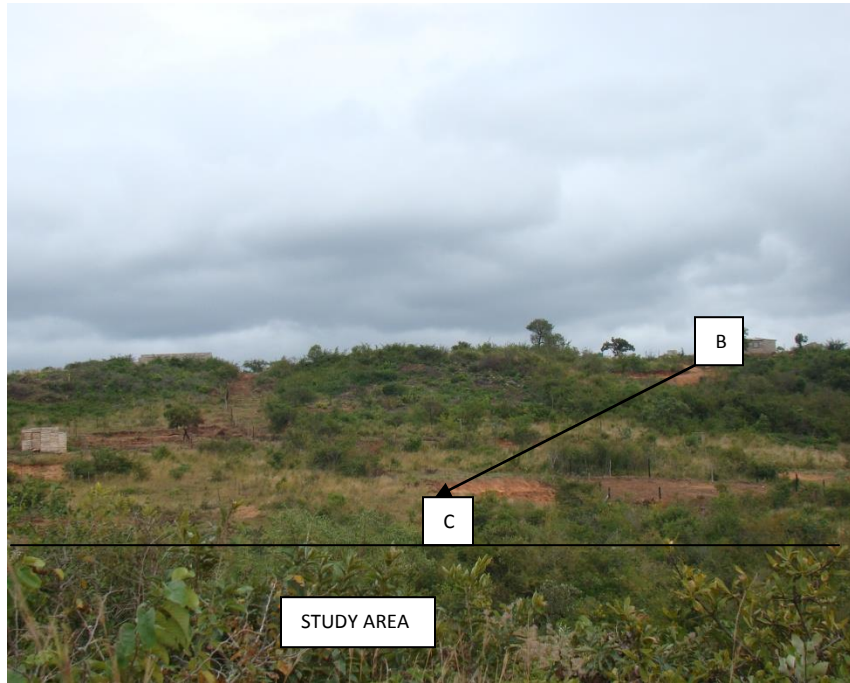


Fig. 4: Points B – C indicate the access road towards the study area.
