**PROPOSED 132 KV TRANSMISSION LINE TO THE ESKOM ARIES SUBSTATION FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A PHOTOVOLTAIC ELECTRICITY GENERATION FACILITY ON PORTIONS 8 AND 12 OF THE FARM OLYVENKOLK NO. 187 KENHARD DISTRICT, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE**

This letter serves to confirm that the entire 8 km long route of the proposed 132 Kv transmission line route to the Eskom Aries substation for the proposed construction of a solar power farm on Portions 8 and 12 of the Farm Olyvenkolk No. 187 has been assessed for archaeological heritage.

During the assessment, only one significant archaeological site (Site # 598) was documented by the consulting archaeologist. Recommendations entail fencing off this site, and making sure that the powerline (including the servitude) does not impact negatively on these important heritage remains.

The findings and recommendations made by the archaeologist have been endorsed by the South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA).
