

History OF Glenwood, Durban

Glenwood is a suburb on the lower Berea in Durban, KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa. The area is known for being commercial in nature for properties along the main roads like Umbilo Road.

Prior to the M4 highway, Umbilo Road formed part of the network of main roads which directed movement into the CBD.

Schools in the area include Glenwood High School, Glenwood Preparatory School (formerly Parkview Primary School), Glenwood Junior Primary School, Open Air School, Penzance Primary School, St. Henry's Marist Brothers' College and Durban Girls' High School.

Glenwood is surrounded by well-known schools as well as tertiary educational institutions (University of Natal & Nelson Mandela School of Medicine) and a key government Medical facility known as King Edward Hospital.
