A total of 27 glass beads from the Department UP Arts, University of Pretoria Museums in Pretoria were handed and temporarily loaned to Dr Koleini on 28 March 2018 and then personally handed to Prof. Lindhal. They were transported to the Laboratory of Laser ablation inductively coupled plasma mass spectrometry (LA-ICP-MS), Department of Geology in Lund University (Sweden).

The beads were securely packed in sealed containers with due consideration to preservations requirements set by the UP Museums to ensure no damage or loss.
