as will further appear in the Diagram framed by the Surveyor, -- on condition that all authorized Roads and Thoroughfares running over this Land, shall remain free and uninterrupted; that said land shall be liable (without compensation to its proprietor,) to have any road made over any part of it, for the public good, by order of Government, except those parts on which buildings may actually be erected at the time when such Road is required to be made; subject also to the general right of all travellers to outspan upon the lands in suitable situations, for not more than 24 hours, (unless longer detained by just cause,) and to such other regulations relative to outspan, as the Government may hereafter deem necessary for the interests of the Public;
