Methodology:

The geology of 24 Riviere near Vaalwater, Limpopo Province where development is proposed to take place, has been studied for a scoping report.

Findings:

The geology of the area is dominated by arenacous rocks of the Waterberg Group which is Mogolian in age (approximately 2 070 to 1 080 Mya). Due to the improbability of fossils occurring in the study area it is recommended that the project should be exempted from further palaeontological studies.
