Re: Notification of the Discovery of Graves

During 2016, it was brought to the attention of Scaw South Africa (Pty) Ltd.'s management that there were graves located at the Union Junction property of Scaw Metals in Dinwiddie, Germiston.

Scaw contracted Archaeos Culture and Cultural Resource Consultants to undertake an assessment. The graves are located within the footprint of a proposed future waste disposal facility. The graves were identified and assessed by the contractor and the area was cordoned off so that access is limited.


The Assessment Report, a copy of which is attached, also indicates that there could potentially be more graves than those that are visible on the surface and it is recommended that a "watching brief before construction" of the disposal facility, be undertaken. This would entail a more invasive investigation in the area to identify any additional graves that may be in the area.

It is however understood that a permit would be required before Scaw can commence with this further investigation.

Please advise what process needs to be followed in this regard and what application forms need to be completed.
