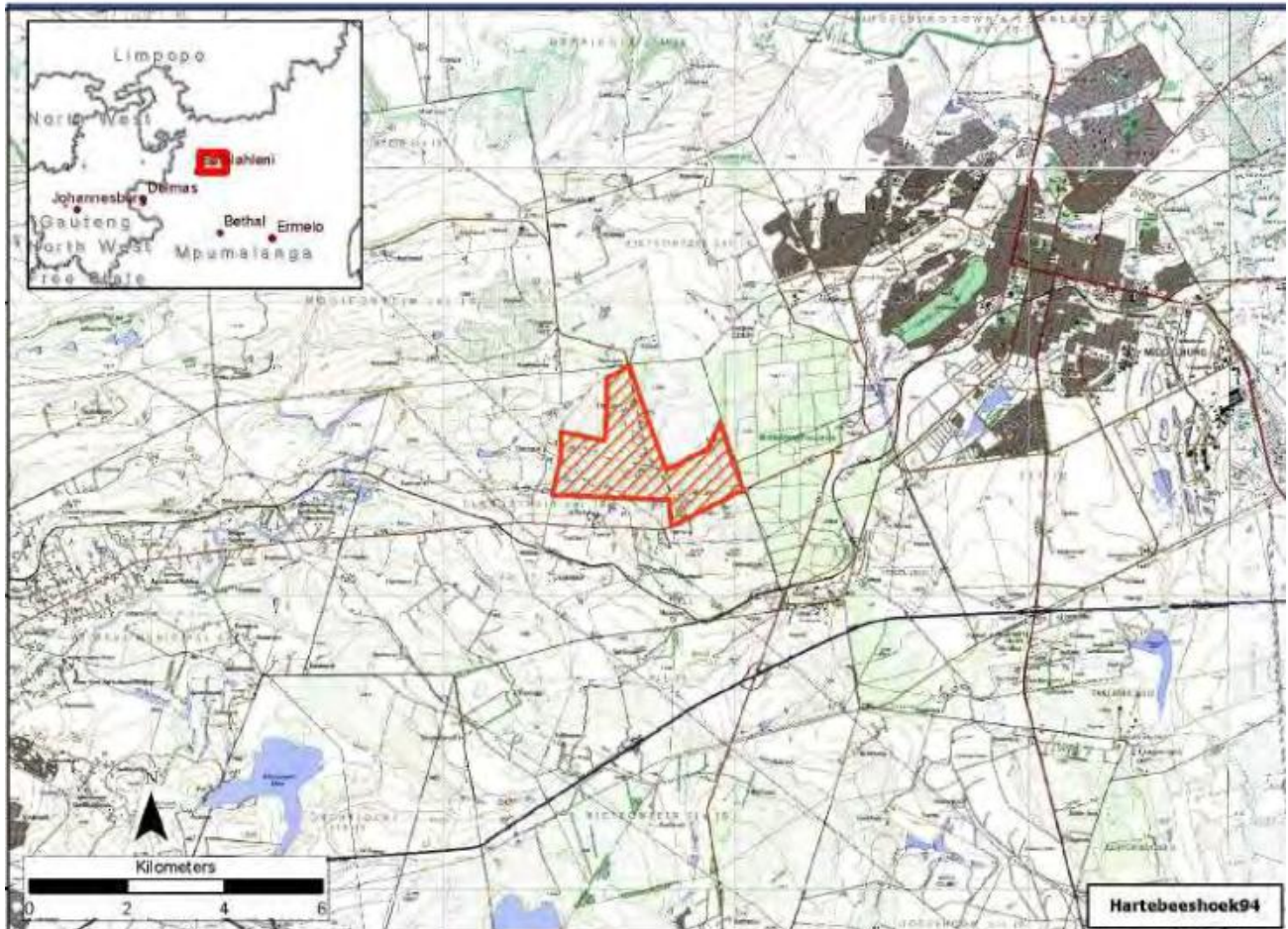


Figure 1- Location of Elandspruit Colliery

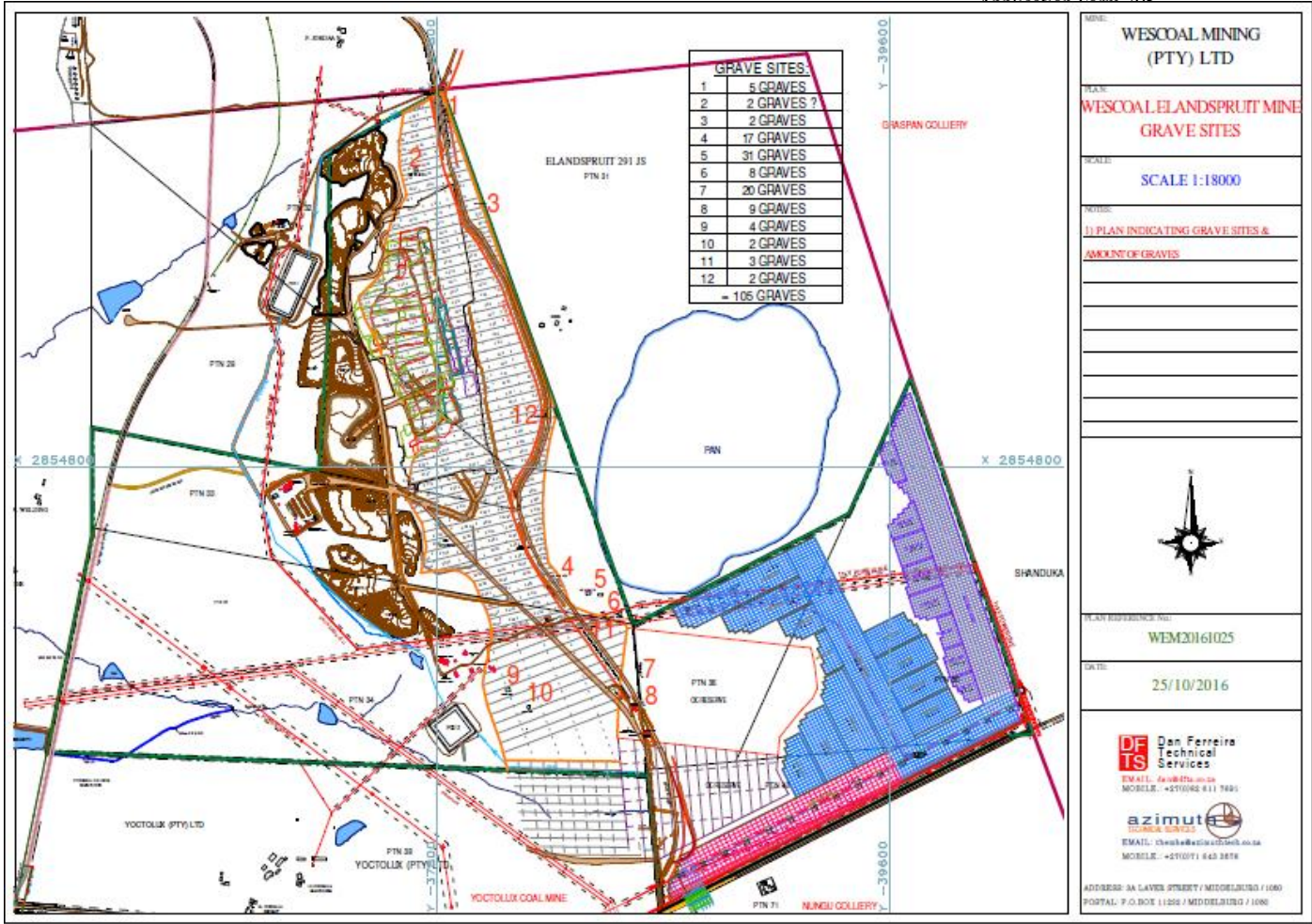


Figure 2-- Location of the Graves within Wescoal Elandspruit Colliery

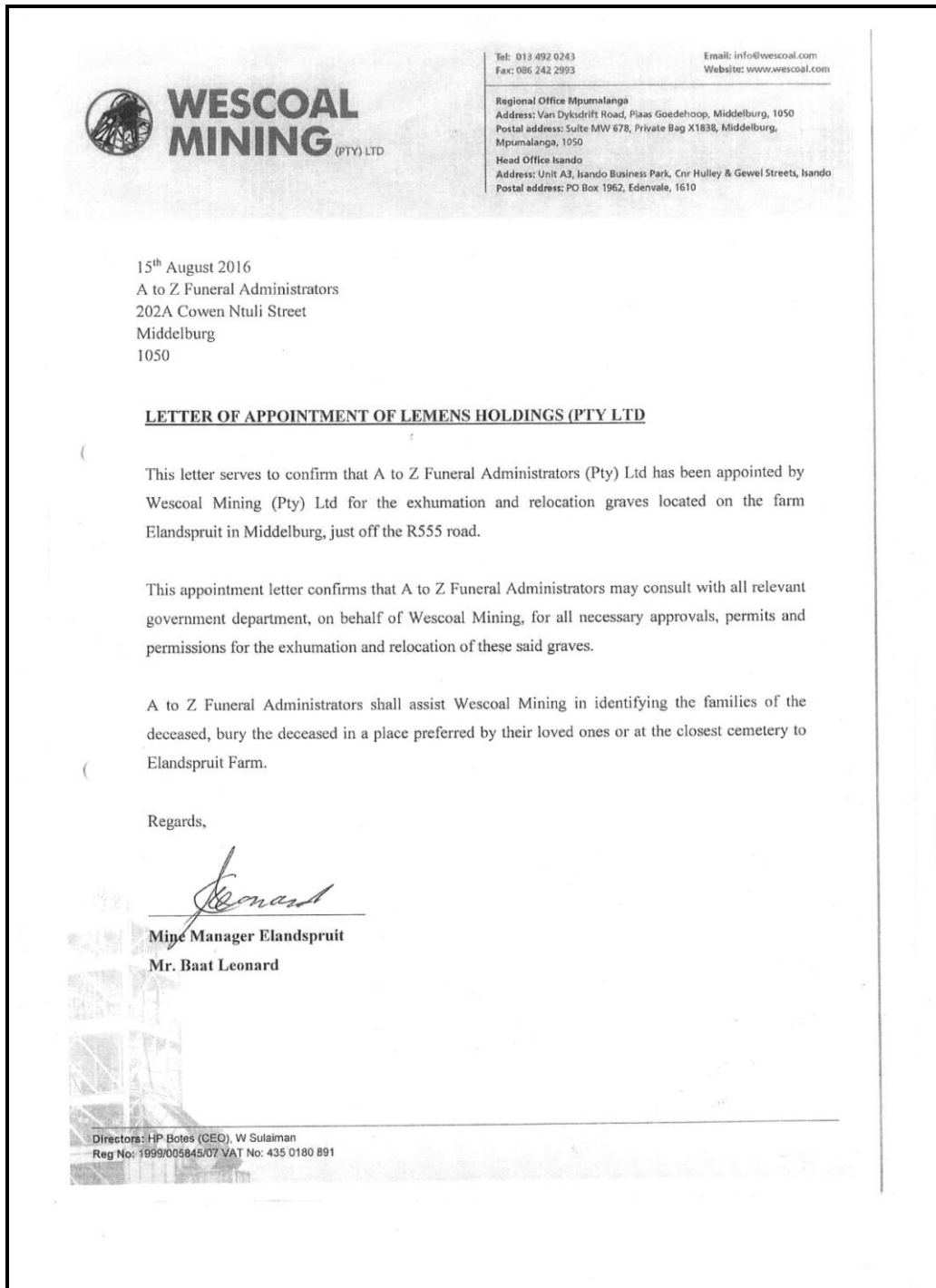


Figure 14– Appointment Letter Wescoal Mining (Pty) Ltd
