The Final Scoping Report was submitted to the DMR on 15 October 2018 and was accepted by the DMR on 14 January 2019.

A request for an extension for submission of the Final Environmental Impact Assessment and Environmental Management Programme Report ("EIA/EMPR") in terms of 23(1) (b) of the EIA Regulations was submitted on 24 January 2019, and accepted on 14 February 2019, providing the applicant an additional 50 days.
