

**RDR 2:** See layout plan (Fig 5). Some of the walls of units A & B are still in good condition. It varies from level with the ground surface to 700mm and 1500mm in height. At points they are 1000mm wide. The majority of the walls, (Unit B 2, C & D) are extremely deteriorated and some units were only identified after the velt was burnt.

**RDR 2 A:**



Photo 23: RDR 2 A: The wall of this unit varies from 920mm to level with the ground surface. The layout pattern is still distinct.

**RDR 2 B**



Photo 29: Unit RDR 2B (1) consists of defined walls in the region of 1m high, to indistinct walls which are level with the ground surface.



Photo 30: A section of a well preserved wall in Unit RDR2B, which is in the extent of 1000mm high.





Photo 31: The same section of this wall is over 1000mm wide.



Photo 32: An upper grinder which was found to the east of Unit RDR2 B (1).





Photo 33: The section of Unit RDR2 B (2), directly adjacent to RDTR2 B (1), is very indistinct and level with the ground surface.

**RDR 2 C:**



Photo 34: Just north of Units RDR2 (A & B) is unit RDR2C. This unit is indistinct and only visible after the velt was burnt.



Photo 35: Traces of walls extending from unit RDR2C, are visible after the veld was burnt, and connects this section with another circular unit (see photo 36).



Photo 36: An extension of Unit RDR2 C, which became visible after the veld was burnt.

**RDR 2 D:**



Photo 41: Unit RDR2C unit is further north of RDR2A, B & C. It is well defined. Highest section: 300mm, but deteriorating fast.
