South32 South Africa, Lefalethu Colliery is proposing to expand its Sterkwater 317 JS Portion 3 known as Goedehoop Section of Middelburg Mines. The Heritage Impact Assessment done by Mulaifa Development Projects in November 2018 identified graves within the proposed mine expansion footprint. Upon classification and consultation with affected communities it was discovered that 2 out of 40 graves are older than 60 years and therefore fall under the jurisdiction SAHRA Burial grounds and Grave Unit and the rest fall under the Human Tissue Act. The identified graves cannot be avoided because open cast mining destroys the entire surface and cuts off access to burial sites. Integrated Specialist Services in collaboration with Mafu' Funeral Home were appointed to conduct Phase 2 mitigation for the affected graves. The later's archaeologists and heritage specialists team conducted a field survey and site condition survey of the mining footprint. The survey confirmed a total of 40 graves distributed at one site within the direct mine footprint. The study was conducted within the framework of the legislation including the section 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act No. 25 of 1999) and will apply the Human Tissue Act (1983). The grave screening exercise revealed that 2 graves are older than 60 years and the rest are less than 60 years and therefore fall under the jurisdiction of the Human Tissue Act.

In accordance with the relevant legislation, Mafu's Funeral Home advertised in the Middleburg Observer 8 October 2018, Witbank News 08 October 2018, eMalahleni FM, Ligwalagwala FM and Ekwekwezi FM (See appendix A) and pasted on site notices as required by the heritage legislation. Potential custodians of the graves responded to the adverts and consultations and grave identification and verification exercise was conducted. Custodians were tracked and they gave consent to the proposed relocation of the affected graves (see attached consent forms).

The costs of this exercise are included in the professional services being provided by Mafu's Funeral Home and Integrated Specialist Services (see attached contract). This includes cost of reburial of final reburial of the human remains. ISS in collaboration with Mafu's Funeral Home has obtained permission for the graves to be re-interred in the Middleburg's Doornkop Cemetery, Hammanskraal Cemetery and Swayedi Cemetery at Monsterlus in Limpopo Province. Mafu's Funeral Home is the approved undertaker service provider and will be Monitored by Integrated Specialist Services to conduct the reburial work. With the necessary arrangements having been agreed upon with South32, and affected family members. We request that the SAHRA BG&G Unit process this urgent application to enable the immediate relocation of the affected graves. The department of Health Mpumalanga has already issued a Burial Permit dated 25 June 2019 for graves that fall under the Human Tissue Act. All the graves at this site belong to families that

are closely related and they wish to relocate them at the same time after conducting rituals for all of them. Endorsements from SAPS Middelburg dated 16 May 2019, Steve Tshwete Local Municipality dated 5 August 2019 were already obtained by Mafu's Funeral Home. The two heritage graves belong to the Mphela Family. The family was duly consulted and the family consented to the relocation of the two-family graves through their elected representatives. (Should there be any other information that the Agency may require in this regard, Integrated Specialist Services will be obliged to make the necessary submissions.

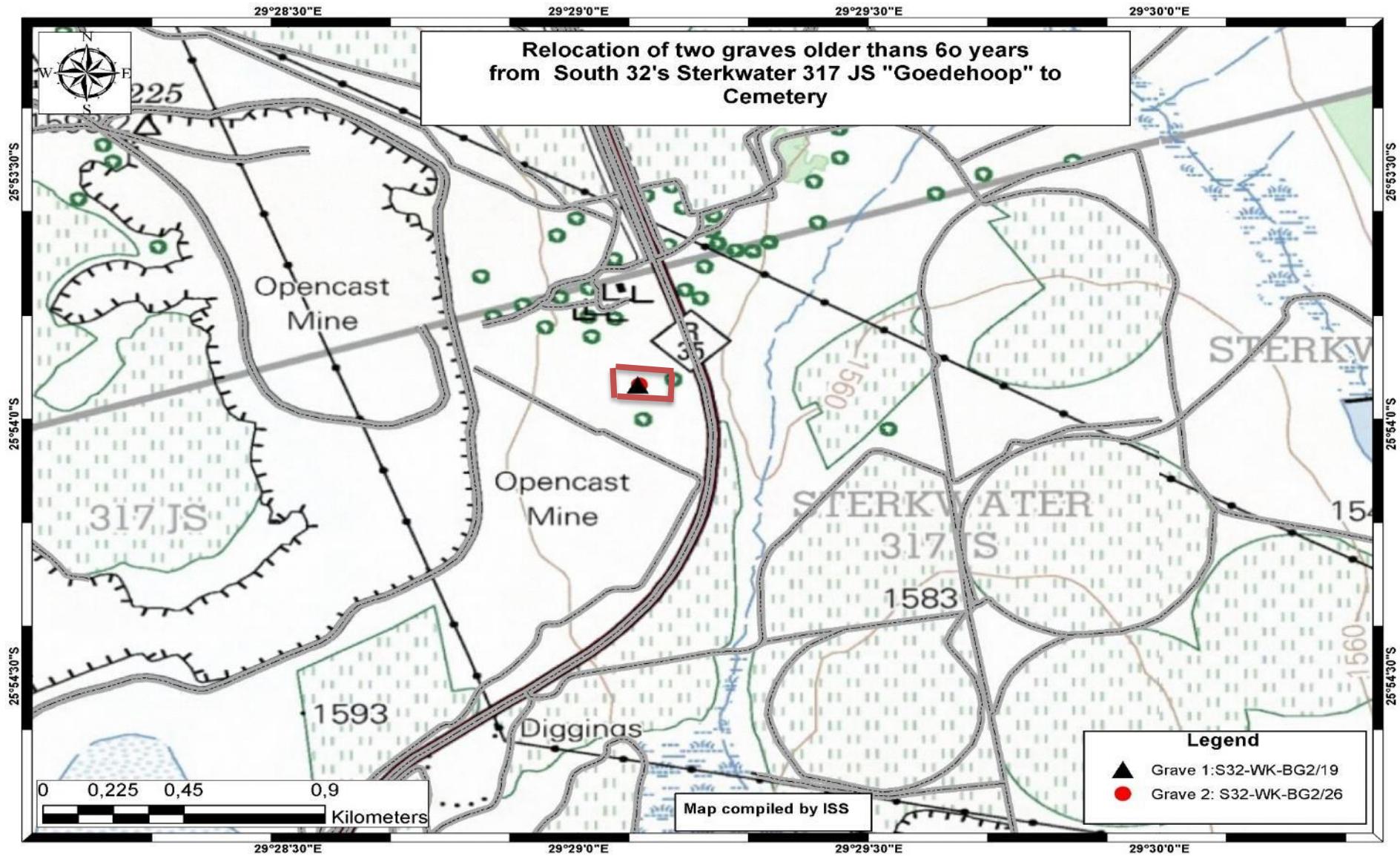




Figure 6 - Locality Map
