I **do not** consider the above firearm/weapon to be a Heritage Object as defined within
the Act, for the following reasons:

IT IS A EXTERNAL HAMMER CARTRIDGE SIDE BY SIDE SHOTGUN CIRCA
1900 IN A RELIC INOPERABLE CONDITION WITH NUMEROUS DEFECTS.

As is evident, it *does not* meet the criteria as defined in the National Heritage
Resources Act, no. 25 of 1999 and, SAHRA therefore *does not* object to the
deactivation/export/destruction as provided for by any other Act affecting such
firearm/weapon.
