**RE: MINOR AMENDMENTS TO THE EMPr AND MOTIVATION REPORTS FOR THE RAINMAKER  
MOLTENO WEF PROJECTS - MALABAR, LOPERBERG AND SPREEUKLOOF  
SAHRIS CASES: 16895, 16894 and 16896**

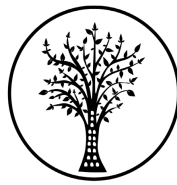
In July 2021, CTS Heritage completed a Desktop Heritage Screening Assessment for the proposed amendments to each of the approved Rainmaker Molteno Wind Energy Facilities - Malabar, Loperberg and Spreeukloof. The desktop heritage review of these amendments were submitted via SAHRIS on 30 July 2021.

Subsequent to the submission on SAHRIS, minor changes to the EMPr and Motivation Report have been made. These changes include a small amendment to text and updates to the bat sensitivity maps as updated on the attached revised Bat Assessments.

The EMPr and the Motivation report both previously used the line: *These areas include 500m around all cliff lines and 200m around all other important bat features and potential roosts*, as put out to the public.

The revised specialist reports use the line - *These areas include 200m around all cliff lines, potential roosts and all other important bat features*. This has been updated in the EMPr and Motivation report.

As the specialist that completed the desktop heritage review of the amendment applications, I can confirm that the minor changes described above have no impact on the conclusions and findings of the Desktop Heritage Screening Assessment for any of the Rainmaker Molteno projects.
