

The accompanying list and maps have been compiled from information at NMC head office and from maps supplied by Paar l Municipality.

A preliminary visual survey of the Main Street was undertaken by NMC staff in 1985. The survey has been incorporated into this list. .

All conservation-worthy buildings have been outlined on the maps and listed. Eff numbers and street numbers are correlated from maps supplied by the Parl Municipality. National Monuments are coloured red and designated NM on the list. Buildings in the process of proclamation are crosshatched and designated ' $A^{\prime}$ on the list. The remaining buildings are classed according to their individual archtectural merit (B) or their environmental importance (C). Some buildings have not been classified due to lack of research time. The buildings have been listed in number order from south to north. A separate page accompanies each map and, for convenience even numbers are listed first, followed by odd numbers. Where available, photographs are included.

The possibility of declaring Main Street a conservation area should be considered, in order to give the Municipality more aesthetic control.

A small dwelling, one of a group of three with stone features. Built in late 19th centry it has been considerably altered, Corregated iron roof has been replaced by black asbestos tiling. Verandah has infill, of facade genestration only the ventilation is original. Building has stone (granite) foundation. Granite featured on verandah walls are interesting, diamond shaped windows. All windows replaced in 1950's by steel framed windows. A further feature of the building is an interesting white washed stone outbuilding at the rear. Stone featured in garden wall and entrance steps. Close to the Main Street, opposite shopping centre of 1950's. Erf belong to property not supported by balancing to the right of the building architectural features.

A single storye L-shaped dewlling of stone under pitched corrugated iron roof. Projecting bay has stone stepped gable. Windows have been replaced but large entrance door with single rectangular fanlight and sideligths is original. Straight corrugated iron verandah roof supported by cast irion pillars with ornamental brackers.

A singel stoned L-shaped dwelling, one of a group of three with facades of stone. Gable of projecting bay is gently holbol with a semi circular louvred ventilator. Pitched roof a corrugated iron and a straight corrugated iron verandah roof is supported by simple masonary pillars.
Fenetration in projecting bay has been replaced by steel framed windows although verandah window and attractive entrance door are original.

The dwelling is set in an attractive small garden surrounded by a paīnted low garden wall. The environment of this property is considerably affected by the commercial activities nearby.

A large imposing dwelling set in a well established terraced garden. Probably built in the 1930's this thatched building has I projecting bays with a verandah between. This has three curved entranced arches and a cimred moulding in the Cape Dutch idiom above. Casement windows are of leaded glass and some windows have sun stullds. Facades is surrounded by low curved garden wall. Stone garden walls and an imposing driveway lead to the house.

A large inposive double storey house in the neo-Spanish style of the late 1920's. Walls are rought plastered and red terra cotta roof tiles add to the Sparish effect: Probably built at the same time as No. 28 , but has been changed. Verandah with curved pillars at entrance has been filled in to create a further roan,

Above this is a large verandah. Front facade has half hipped roof supported by masonary brackets. Casement windows of teak have leaded glass. The building is an impressive garden with an old granite garden wall.

A large double storey dwelling with very similar stylistic features to No. 30. Walls are rough, plastered and roofing is of red terra cotta. Probably built in the 1920's, the building has a very sympathetic addition to the R-wing. Casement windows are of teak and like no. 30 have leaded glass. Plastered walls have brick detailing at the foundation level and some corner brick rustication. Brick pillars support entrance portico. The house has a fine granite garden wall and steps and a well established garden with oak trees.
